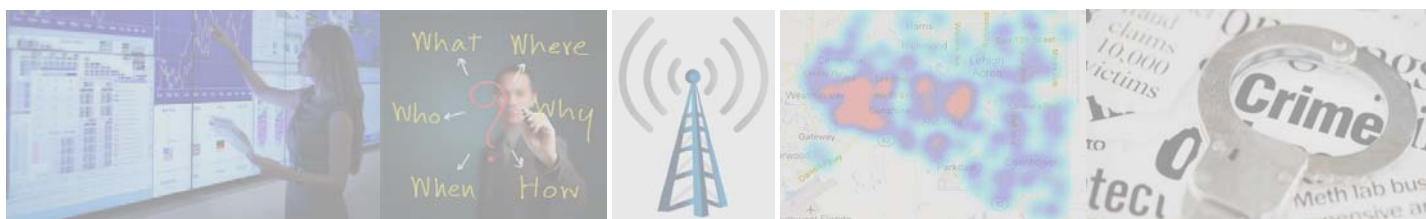
### 2017 California Crime & Intelligence Analysis Conference
