RULES

- This show is approved by the International Lama Registry Show Division.
- All animals entered in approved classes **must be** registered with the International Lama Registry (ILR) or have an ILR Tracking Number. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show.
- No dogs are allowed within the show barn.
- Exhibitors must be the registered owners and make entry in the exact names (owner and animal) as shown on the registration certificate or have written permission from the owner to show that animal.
- No llama under the age of five months may be shown.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have animals(s) at the show ring promptly for their class.
- Llamas may not be moved from one class to another after halter judging has begun, except at the judge's discretion.
- Youth may exhibit only one entry **per** youth class.
- A llama may only be used in **one** performance division.
- Youth may compete in Novice or Advanced Performance and Youth Performance; however they must use a different llama.
- Individual animals entered in the Production class may be decided after halter classes. However, they must be listed with the show clerk before this class is held.
- It is recommended that exhibitors 7-11 years of age not show intact males over the age of 18 months.
- Alpacas may compete in the llama performance classes; however, there are no separate alpaca classes.
- An animal may be entered in only **ONE** halter class.
- All animals will be entered in **BOTH** ILR and ALSA as this is a dual sanctioned show. If you are not an ALSA member you will need to pay the \$50 non-member fee or you can contact Becci Kunkel to become a member. ALSAshowsec@gmail.com

- HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: The State of Iowa requires health papers for transportation purposes on all out of state exhibitors within 30 days of the show.

SHOW TIME: 8:30 A.M. Saturday and 8:30 A.M. Sunday. PLEASE BE PROMPT!! Once the class has entered the ring and the gate is closed, late exhibitors may not enter a class.

EXHIBITOR MEETING: 8:00 A.M. Saturday only

ENTRY DEADLINE: September 9th, 2023 (Postmarked)

ARRIVAL & REGISTRATION: Any time after 3:30 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. on Friday September 22, 2023. Registration will be open again on Saturday morning from 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.

RELEASE: Llamas may leave any time after they have completed showing.

FEES:

CLASS FEE: \$15.00 per performance & showmanship (single point), \$25.00 Halter (double point)

SUB-JUNIOR CLASSES: FREE - BUT PLEASE INCLUDE ON ENTRY FORMS

ILR/ALSA SHOW MANAGER FEE: \$8 PER ANIMAL

ENTRY DEADLINE: September 9th, 2023

LATE ENTRY FEE: \$50.00 per farm after September 9th, 2023

ENTRY CHANGES: \$15.00 for each entry change after September 16th. (included adding a class, changing a class, and animal substitution)

STALLING: The stalls will be metal 10' x 10' with concrete floors. No more than 2 animals per stall, unless they are under one year old. Exhibitors provide their own feed and bedding (**straw and paper are allowed**). If you are sharing stalls with someone, please indicate this on your entry form. We will try our best to honor all stalling requests, however, it may not be possible. Due to a limited number of stalls please only reserve stalls for your animals. Tack can be placed in the aisles and the building will be locked up every night. Stalls will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. **Entries will close when stalls are sold out.** There is a wash area on the South side of the Llama Barn (Anniversary Hall).
