# **Did You Know?**

Scott Memorial Fountain on Belle Isle was built in 1924 at a cost of \$500,000. It opened in May of 1925 with cowboy movie star, Tom Mix, turning on the water for the first time!

This Detroit treasure has flowed for years as the backdrop for many photos of families, wedding parties and other joyous occasions. Lord knows how many people tested the fountain's waters due to a dare or from liquid courage.

The fountain was named after James Scott, who never held a political office or accomplished any major service to the city. In fact, Scott had inherited his money & was scorned by many. He owned land on Grand River and chased off any trespassers. In the bars he frequented, he was often crass. loud and at times profane. In his will he bequeathed a sizable sum of money for a fountain on Belle Isle with the condition that a statue of himself be built nearby. Because the man was so disliked, it took years for the city fathers to make it happen. Scott finally got his fountain long after he died in 1910!
