



Thanks to the devotion and service of Sister Audrey Dailey, we have been able to provide assistance to The CRIB and their ministry. We praise God that we can help in this much needed service.

Mother's Day is coming our way: That means starting today April 2 and going through May 7 we will be collecting items for The CRIB. Please place your gifts in the crib in the back of the auditorium. The following items are being collected:



<u>Baby Items</u>: diapers, wipes, bottles, pacifiers, blankets, books, wash clothes, towels, safety locks, clothing for newborn to 4T, shampoo, lotion, rash cream, baby cereal, and baby food/juice.

<u>For the Teen Mom</u>: personal care items: shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush, combs, soap, deodorant, towels, wash clothes, twin sheets, and laundry soap.
