## Lake Shadows Pool Rules and Information

Welcome to the Lake Shadows Pool! We want all of our families to have an enjoyable experience this summer. This document will answer some of your questions as well outline the pool rules. Please discuss these rules with your children so that we can have a safe and fun swimming season.

The Lake Shadows Pool is meant to be used by all property owners who are current on their HOA dues. By purchasing pool tags or guest passes, you are helping to pay for the expense, maintenance and upkeep of the pool. It's very expensive to operate the pool, so every little bit helps...we thank you for your support!

You may purchase a Pool Tag for \$30 each. If you have more than 4 family members, each tag after the 4<sup>th</sup> is \$10each. A tag may be purchased for the immediate family of the homeowner. This will include homeowner, spouse and children who live at the residence. A grandparent can also purchase tags for their children or grandchildren. Families who rent homes in Lake Shadows can purchase tags for their family with proof of residence (lease or rental agreement) as long as the owner of their property is current on their dues. Your tags may be purchased from the Pool Manager/ Supervisor or lifeguard once the pool has opened for the season.

If you prefer not to purchase a seasonal pool pass you may swim for a daily fee of \$5.00 per day. The same rules will apply; your HOA dues must be current. You may also purchase a guest pass for your family or friends that are visiting you for the day and would like to spend time at the pool. The property owner must always be present with their guests. Guest fees must be paid in cash or from a check written by the property owner, no checks will be accepted from a renter or non-property owner. No exceptions! All guests not monitoring children will be required to pay \$5.00 per day entrance fee.

The pool will open Memorial Day weekend, then weekends only until school is out. Afterwards, the pool hours will be Tuesday-Saturday 1-7 and Sunday 1-6. The pool is closed on Mondays for maintenance. If you are interested in a pool party, the pool may be rented for \$65 per hour for 20 people and under. One lifeguard is included in that fee. If you have more than 21 people with in the gates of the pool, then you will need 1 lifeguard and 1 monitor, which will cost \$75 per hour. The pool can only be rented during non-operating hours (9am-11:30am then 7:00pm-10pm Friday & Saturday, 9am-11:30am then 7pm-9pm Tuesday-Thursday & Sunday) but never on Mondays.

The monitors/lifeguards will have complete authority at the pool. If you do not want to follow their direction, then you must leave the pool area. If you wish to discuss the matter further with the pool manager, you may do so at another time, but at that moment, the monitor/lifeguard has the authority. Any person posing a severe danger to themselves or others will be asked to leave the pool area immediately. For not following the rules, the monitor/lifeguard is authorized to put the person in "time out", sitting at a distance from the pool for 15 minutes. A second offense that day will result in the person being expelled from the pool for the day. In order to re-enter the pool, the person or parent of the person under 18 will need to have a conference with the pool manager to try to resolve the issue. If a person has been expelled from the pool for a severe infraction of the rules, he will need to address the LS Board at the next regularly scheduled meeting before having access to the pool again.

Children must be 13 years old or older by June 1<sup>st</sup> to swim without an adult's supervision. In order to supervise a child 12 or under, the person must be 18 years old or older by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

All toddlers must be potty trained or wear a "little swimmer". The same water and filter system is used for both the wading and large pool, so this is an important health issue.

NO INFLATABLES WITH THE EXPECTION OF SWIM AIDS FOR THE YOUNG CHILDREN

NO "NOODLES"

NO PETS

NO SMOKING IN POOL OR DECK AREA – SMOKING ALLOWED IN GRASSY AREA ONLY

ABSOLUTELY NO UNDERAGE SMOKING

A SWIM TEST MUST BE COMPLETED TO ENTER THE DIVING AREA

ONE AT A TIME ON THE DIVING BOARD, OBEY ALL RULES ON THE BOARD

PICK UP ALL TRASH WHEN LEAVING

WHEN GOING INTO THE LAKE, A SHOWER AND CHANGE OF CLOTHES ARE REQUIRED TO RE-ENTER POOL
