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# Frequently Discussed Tax Topics

## Online Tax Payments

You can pay your Lincoln Township taxes online! Please note that there is a 3% fee that will be charged to your credit card for this service; this fee is paid to the merchant processing the transaction.

## Payments

For winter tax season, you can make payments anytime between December 1 and March 1, 2021. Only remaining balances are factored into the delinquent interest.

## Postmark

Postmark is NOT accepted for winter tax bills. It is recommended that tax payments are mailed by February 20, 2021. All payments must be received by 5 pm on March 1, 2021. Any parcels not fully paid will be turned over to the County Treasurer at 8 am on March 2, 2021.

## Winter Tax Receipts

If you include your email address, your summer and winter tax receipt will be emailed to you rather than mailed.

## NSF Checks

There is a \$25.00 fee for any check returned to the township unpaid.

## Tax Bills

Newaygo County generates the tax bills and outsources to a printing company for mailing. Combining multiple parcels into one envelope is not an option any longer.

## Homestead Exemption

If you recently filed for 100% PRE and your current bill doesn't reflect it, you need to contact the assessor immediately to have it adjusted for this tax season. If you miss December Board of Review, you will need to pay the entire amount and then receive a refund in early June.

## Property Changed Names

If you recently sold your property and the change wasn't filed in time for bill printing, you can forward your bill to the new owner or you can call me with their information and I will send them a new bill.
