## **CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE**

## Reply to Customer 2855491 Overnightline®:

California Proposition 65 (the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) refers to the California legislation that was intended by its authors to protect California citizens and the State's drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and to inform citizens about exposures to such chemicals.

California Proposition 65 (CA Prop 65) requires businesses to notify Californians about significant amounts of chemicals in the products they purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By providing this information, CA Prop 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about protecting themselves from exposure to these chemicals. CA Prop 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

This letter certifies that as of the date of this letter, regarding the Hoffmaster or Creative Converting or GMSP 2-Ply Beverage and Lunch Napkins sold to Balloon House, the Hoffmaster Group, Inc. has reviewed the raw materials used to manufacture these products in order to assure that the products are in compliance with the Act. These reviews have revealed that the above mentioned products are in compliance with CA Prop 65, and to the best of our knowledge, we have no reason to believe that during any part of our processes is anything intentionally added that would violate the Act.

Therefore, these Items sold to Overnightline® at the time of this review do not require CA Prop 65 warning statements.
