Piedmont Junior Golf Tournament - 2018

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES *

- These guidelines are in effect from the time you enter the host club facility until you leave that facility.
- All boys must wear golf shirts with collars and <u>shirt tails tucked inside shorts or pants</u>; T-shirts, tank tops, athletic jerseys, etc. are not acceptable.
- Girls' shirts must be golf-type shirts. Girls' shirts must have collars and may or may not have sleeves, but must be tucked in at all times.
- Bermuda-length shorts must be mid-thigh or longer. **Unacceptable apparel includes**; tennis shorts, gym shorts, short-shorts, or cut-off jeans.
- Soft spikes golf shoes or tennis shoes are required at all golf courses.

CONDUCT GUIDELINES *

Any conduct that is deemed detrimental to the Piedmont Junior Golf Association will not be tolerated. Such conduct includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Consumption of any alcoholic beverages
- Smoking and/or use of any tobacco products
- Drug use
- Gambling
- Profanity
- Abusive language
- Club throwing
- Damage or abuse of host facility property or golf course

Any flagrant breach of the above guidelines will result in automatic disqualification from, the event where the incident occurred. The degree of flagrancy is entirely at the discretion of the officials in charge of the competition. The player will also be disqualified from the next event entered. Two disqualifications will result in suspension from the Piedmont Junior Golf

CARE FOR THE GOLF COURSE*

All players are expected to maintain, as well as improve the conditions of, the golf course by replacing divots, repairing ball marks, raking bunkers and, picking up and properly disposing of trash or debris left on the course. Leave the golf course better than you found it!

HONESTY AND INTEGRITY*

• Honesty and integrity are an important part of golf and any cheating of any type will not be tolerated and will result in immediate disqualification and suspension from remaining events.

Parent/Spectator Guidelines *

Parents and spectators are an essential part of making the Piedmont Junior Golf Association a great learning experience. We urge you to support the development of juniors in golf by following these guidelines.

- Players competing in the Junior Golf division must walk and carry their own golf bag (pull carts allowed if permitted by host club). Caddies are not allowed.
- Spectators that are walking are not allowed to walk with the players!
- (Spectators may walk near the greens to watch the players putt out.)
- Spectator carts will be allowed, when available from the host facility. All carts are to remain on the provided paths no exceptions. In the event there are no paths provided, carts should be at least 20 yards from the fairway of the hole being played. Spectators using carts must observe posted club rules when operating the vehicle.
- DO NOT GIVE ADVICE TO ANY PLAYER! (Rule 8, 2008 *Rules of Golf*). <u>Best policy is to not talk to the participants during a competitive round.</u>
- Abusive language, swearing, and alcoholic beverages will not be permitted on the club property or golf course.
- Do not disrupt the pace or flow of play.
- Please pick up any trash you may see left by the juniors on the course.
- If you think you see a rules infraction, inform a rules official as soon as possible so the situation may be resolved prior to the player signing his/her scorecard. Do not suggest or give rulings on your own.

• I hereby release the Piedmont Junior Golf and any golf course on which any Jr. event is held, and their respective officers, directors, employees and volunteers from any and all claims for any injuries or damages arising out of, resulting or related to any Piedmont Junior Golf event. I understand and agree to support and abide by the Virginia State Golf Association Code of Conduct and the Parent/Spectator Guidelines at all times.
