

## HERITAGE OAK PARK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT PUBLIC FACILITIES REPORT SEPTEMBER 2016

The Heritage Oak Park Community Development District (the "District") currently owns and operates the community clubhouse/pool/maintenance garage property and parking lot, streets, street lighting, master stormwater management system, master irrigation system, perimeter landscape buffer areas, and entry gates/guard house throughout the District which is located within Section 8, Township 40 South, Range 22 East, in Charlotte County, Florida.

The current capacity of the District's facilities is not quantifiable, but the facilities appear to have been constructed in conformance with the community's design and construction permits with all facilities currently considered to be operating at acceptable levels. The community is currently fully developed with no additional demands currently anticipated to utilize the District's facilities.
