New Business

1. Cheer team - Ben R. came to present his request of \$1500.00 that will Help the competition costs for basketball and football. There are fees for them for the nationals plus hotel costs and the cost of the bus. They have helped with 2 concessions and the vendor fair and have done other fundraisers such as a cheesecake sale. They have met the expectation and so the request was approved.

2. South High - Sophomore class has an event called New Frontiers which helps with emotions, respect, and empathy in the class. Josh K. reported that the cost is \$8,000 to \$9,000. Last year's color run helped with some of the cost, but the color run will not be until spring this year. \$1500.00 is being requested to help the sophomore class and the request was approved.

3. Boys Swim Team - Tyler H. came to request money to help offset the cost of the touch pads. They are \$1,000.00 a piece. This is Tyler's 3rd season. He reported that they have had a swim-a-thon and other contributions towards the different swim competitions. They are still rebuilding after losing 6 seniors and they try to share things with the girls' team. The Jr. Redwing's fundraiser money went to the girls' team. The request was approved for \$1500.00.

4. The spring vendor fair will be in early March.

5. Basketball will be having their own concessions on Dec. 1st, 29th, and Feb. 24th.

6. Feb. 9th there may be a possible wrestling tournament.

7. Forensics will also be having an event on Feb. 23rd.
