



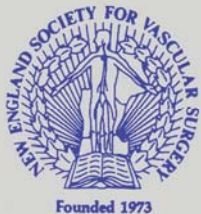

Meeting Description

The Annual Meeting of the New England Society for Vascular Surgery is designed to provide 2 1/2 days of comprehensive educational experiences in the fields of vascular surgery and disease, related sciences and socioeconomic aspects of vascular surgical care.

It is the Society's intent to bring together surgeons, physicians, researchers, fellows, residents, students and allied health professionals from around New England to discuss their latest clinical and research findings on various topics in vascular surgery and to collaborate to construct a robust program on current controversies or topics within the vascular community.

Target Audience

The Annual Meeting is presented for the benefit of those physicians, surgeons, researchers, residents, fellows and allied health professionals involved in the study, treatment and cure of vascular disease.

Application Deadline

All applications for support and exhibit space must be received by **Tuesday, August 13, 2019**. A 50% deposit is due with completed application, with the remaining balance due by the August 13 deadline.

Meeting Registration

Exhibitor personnel must be pre-registered by **Thursday, August 29, 2019**. The personnel registration form can be found online at www.nesvs.org.

Each exhibiting company is allotted two badges per tabletop space purchased. Additional badges are \$300.⁰⁰ each. Cancellations/Refunds

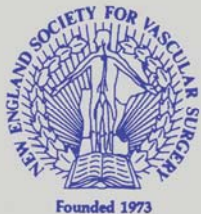

Exhibit Space

Each exhibit space will include one 6' x 30" draped table and two chairs. Exhibits will be tabletop only. No freestanding floor displays will be permitted. Standing equipment may be used in lieu of a table, but request must be sent in writing to the Society's Administrative Office for approval. There will be no pipe and drape. Exhibits will be located in the Narragansett A & B at the Omni Providence Hotel.

Installation/Dismantling

All exhibits must be set in the Narragansett A & B between 3:00 pm - 6:00 pm on Thursday, September 12. Assembly of exhibits during scheduled exhibit hours (see above) will **not** be permitted.

All exhibits must remain intact until the official closing time of 12:00 pm on Saturday, September 14 and may not be dismantled or removed - in whole or in part - before that time. After the close of exhibits, all materials must be removed by 3:00 pm.

Space Assignment

Preferred space will be given to the Society's supporters (if application is received by the posted deadline of Tuesday, August 13). After the deadline, all other companies will be assigned in the order in which the applications with payment are received. Exhibitors wishing to avoid assignment of space adjacent to a particular company should indicate this on their application. Careful consideration will be given to such requests, but cannot be guaranteed. The NESVS has the right to alter the floor plan at any time.

Shipping Information

Shipping instructions will be emailed to exhibiting companies after the deadline.

Security

The exhibit hall will be locked when exhibits are closed, but the safekeeping of the exhibitor's property shall remain the responsibility of the exhibitor. The New England Society for Vascular Surgery and the Omni Providence Hotel are not responsible for theft, loss or damage that may occur and advise each exhibitor to insure their stands, equipment and material at full value.

Conducting Exhibits

No drawings, raffles or quiz-type contests of any type will be permitted. No bags or containers for collection of samples are to be distributed by an exhibitor. This applies to any envelope, folder, portfolio, box, etc. that provides carrying space for more than a single sample. Electrical or other mechanical apparatus must be muffled so noise does not interfere with other exhibitors. Character of the exhibits is subject to approval of the conference organizers. The right is reserved to refuse applications of concerns not meeting standards required or expected, as well as the right to curtail exhibits or parts of exhibits, which reflect against the character of the meeting. This applies to displays, literature, advertising, novelties, souvenirs, conduct of person, etc.

Liability

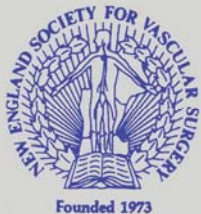
The exhibitor assumes entire responsibility and hereby agrees to protect, indemnify, defend and save the New England Society for Vascular Surgery, Omni Providence Hotel and its officers, employees and agents, harmless against all claims, losses or damages to persons or property, governmental charges or fines and attorney fees arising out of or caused by exhibitor installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of the exhibition premises or a part thereof, excluding any such liability caused by the sole negligence, gross negligence or willful misconduct of the New England Society for Vascular Surgery, Omni Providence Hotel, its employees and agents. Exhibitor acknowledges that the New England Society for Vascular Surgery and the Omni Providence Hotel do not maintain insurance covering the exhibitor's property and thus, it is the sole responsibility and obligation of the exhibitor to obtain business interruption and property damage insurance covering such losses by exhibitor.

Protection of Hotel

Exhibitors will be held liable for any damage caused to the hotel property and no material or matter of any kind shall be posted on, tacked, nailed, screwed or otherwise attached to columns, walls, floors or other parts or portions of the building or furnishings. Whatever may be necessary to properly protect the building, equipment or furniture will be installed at the expense of the exhibitor. If any controversy arises as to the need or propriety thereof, the Convention Service Manager of the hotel will be the final judge thereof and his/her decision shall be binding on all parties concerned.

Fire Protection

All materials used in the exhibit area must be flame-proof and fire-resistant in order to conform to the local fire ordinances and in accordance with regulations established by the local Fire Department. Crepe paper or other paper is not to be used in crating merchandise. Display racks, signs, spotlights and special equipment must be approved before use, and all displays are subject to inspection by the Fire Prevention Bureau. Any exhibit or parts thereof found not to be fire-proof may be dismantled. All aisles and exits must be kept clear at all times. Fire stations and fire extinguisher equipment are not to be covered or obstructed.

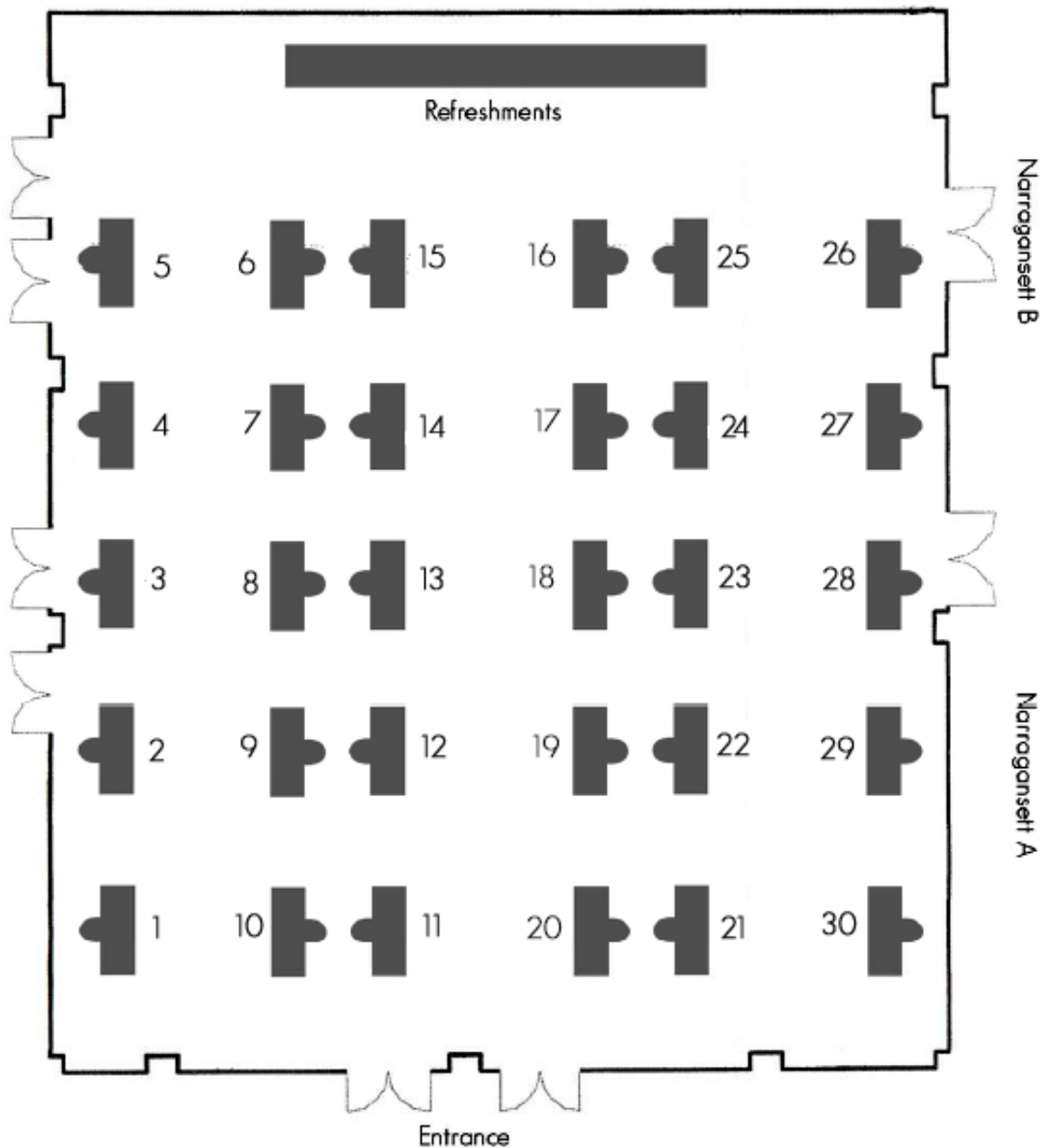


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Floor Plan

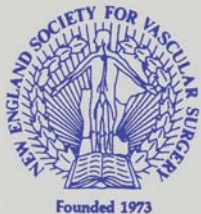
Visiting Providence
