

Explanation of the Auxiliary Wheel

As with everything – there is a chain of command and it goes as follows –

“Outer Rim” represents our National organization, the coordinator of the program, the front and spokesperson.

“Inner Rim” is the Department. The link between the local units and the National Organization.

“The Hub” represents the organization in the community, the unit, the most important part of the overall wheel.

“The Twelve Spokes” represents the twelve months of the year, when the administration will carry forth the programs, the objectives of the organization within the community.

With only twelve months in the year to develop all programs it is necessary to combine some of the programs.

What type of image does your Unit have in your Community? It is up to you to ensure that it is a good one.

Everyone must cooperate in order for the wheel to work.

Although the District is not portrayed in the wheel, it is the link between Department and Unit. With over 86 units within our State, the District officers can assist units prior to units going to Department.
