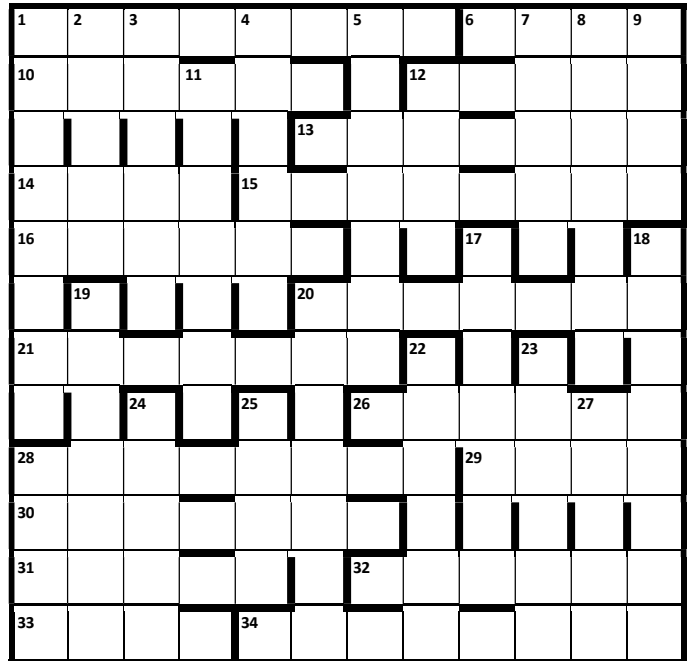


Where's The Beef? - by Peter Green

For each of the 8 letter answers in this puzzle the answer word is a combination of two 4 letter words (i.e. drawback or turnpike). For these answer words I have clued each 4 letter part separately and it the solver's responsibility to determine which 4 letter word pairs with which.

The clues are presented in alphabetical order of the answer word and the answers include 6 capitalized words, 1 archaic word and 1 abbreviation.

When completed properly both the 4 corners and the 4 central squares can each be anagrammed into a 4 letter word. These 2 words can then be combined into an 8 letter word descriptive of the title of the puzzle.
