

# “God’s ‘Temple-Expanding’ Plan”

## 2 Samuel 7:1-17

A quick recap of 2 Samuel 2-6:

1) Sometimes God will say “N\_\_\_\_\_” to something that you or I think is best R\_\_\_\_\_, N\_\_\_\_\_, because He has something much bigger and better down the L\_\_\_\_\_.  
(David misunderstood The Lord’s P\_\_\_\_\_)

Jesus said: “One greater than the T\_\_\_\_\_ is here” (Matthew 12:6)

Paul said: “Don’t you know that you, yourselves, are God’s T\_\_\_\_\_ and that the Holy Spirit L\_\_\_\_\_ in you?”  
(1 Corinthians 3:16)

2) The bigger plans that God has for you and for me  
T\_\_\_\_\_ only become realized when we are  
A\_\_\_\_\_ in Him. (John 15:5)  
God reveals T\_\_\_\_\_ David this forever covenant that will come  
T\_\_\_\_\_ David based on the abiding O\_\_\_\_\_ David

3) Our role is to simply put the S\_\_\_\_\_ out there. God’s  
job is to grow that S\_\_\_\_\_  
(King Solomon got to actually build the physical temple in Jerusalem,  
but King David helped to I\_\_\_\_\_ lay the G\_\_\_\_\_ for  
that temple).

temple-building.
