


Ecclesiastical appointment for the Diocese of Moncton. As of August 1st, 2024, the following appointments will be effective for the following priests.

- 1. Father Louis-Joseph Boudreau will take a well-deserved retirement from parish ministry after many years of service in the Diocese of Moncton. Father Jackson Fabius is appointed priest moderator for the Unité pastorale Saint-Esprit, comprising the parishes of Saint-Henri (Barachois); Sacré-Coeur (Haute Aboujagane); Sainte-Thérèse d'Avila (Cap-Pele / Shemogue). Father Savio Mazerolle will continue as assistant priest with Father Jackson Fabius.
- 2. Father Aduel Joachin is assigned as dominical vicar for the John Paul II Pastoral Unit, which includes the following parishes: Notre-Dame-de l'Assomption (Cathedral); Notre-Dame-de-Grace, Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix, and Christ-Roi. In addition, he will serve the priests of the diocese as a substitute from time to time. He will collaborate with Father Wislais Simervil, moderator.
- 3. Father Jean Bernard Mallais is named chaplain of the two Moncton hospitals, from Wednesday to Sunday.
- 4. Father Damien Nwachukwu is appointed administrator of the parishes of St. Bernard (Moncton); St. Vincent (Sackville); St. Clement (Port Elgin). He will be assisted by Father Juan Carlos Jacinto. Father Charles Broderick will be taking a well deserved retirement from parish ministry in these parishes, where he has been assistant and administrator over the years.
- 5. Father Mikély Jn Simon, CSC, is appointed assistant priest in the parishes of Saint-Jean-Baptiste (Bouctouche), Sainte-Anne de Kent, Sainte-Marie and Saint Paul, beginning at mid August with Father Jean Guy Dallaire as moderator.

We would also like to welcome our new Head Cook/Manager Barb Mackenzie and our new Assistant Manager/Cook, Leigh Burke.


