Franklin Hodges, 511 East Maple Street addressed the Board concerning opening up his race track (Hillbilly Speedway).
Hodges gave examples of the race tracks that are open; Rogersville, Midway, I-44, Urbana, and Bolivar is opening up this weekend. Hodges think he can open and comply with the 6 feet spacing rule. The only track around that is not open is Springfield Speedway; which is in Greene County. Our race track really needs to open, we have spent a lot of money on the track. Bass Pro and Battlefield mall are open. Don't see why we cannot open.
Danderson stated the city has followed Greene County the whole way, need to continue playing by their rules. If Board changes rules for one, there will be others coming to request too (baseball-soccer). Mallard agrees with Danderson. Ault asked if there were any other businesses in town that are not able to open at this time. Ault is for allowing Hodges to open if proper precautions are taken.
Danderson-at some point the city may want to break away from following Greene County but that has not happened yet.
Motion by Danderson to stick to Greene County regulations which unfortunately means Hillbilly Speedway can't open at this time. Second Mallard.
Ault no, Mallard aye, Danderson aye, Roe aye. Motion passes.
