PRESIDENT'S LETTER

MARCH-APRIL 1986

With the arrival of Spring comes the final round of play for the 1985-86 Fall/Winter dart season of the D.D.A.

With the inception of the 27/39 point system this year it has been surprising to find many divisional point races so close at the end of each round. In some cases a championship hinged on a single point.

As of this writing there has been only one complaint of the new scoring system, so I believe it is here to stay for the immediate future.

The divisional play-offs will be played in our sponsors' pubs/taverns as this seems to be consistant with our atmosphere of league play. To hold our play-offs in a hall does not tend to exhibit the atmosphere under which the finalists of each division played to gain such position. As in the past, no team will have "home field advantage in that play-offs will be scheduled in neutral locations unless both teams involved were sponsored by the same pub/tavern this year.

The annual banquet is scheduled for Saturday, June 7, at Greenmont Recreation Hall. As was the Summer League last year, there is no fee for D.D.A. members or sponsors. As more details become available they will be mailed to our sponsors to be posted with the weekly standings.

The banquet was moved into June due to league play being completed May 8. This will allow us every possible effort to have this year's awards available for presentation being as our suppliers require 30 days to deliver our order.

Also, as in past years, the election of officers for the D.D.A. Board of Directors will take place at he banquet. This year the

positions of Vice-President and three Trustee seats are open for election. Each of these have a term of two years.

Mail a request to the league before May 30 if you wish to have your name on this year's ballot. Floor nominations will be accepted just prior to voting.

Division singles and doubles competition will take place during May this year. Wednesday divisions' singles will be played Wednesday, May 21, and doubles on Wednesday, May 38. Thursday divisions' singles will be Thursday, May 22, with doubles competition on Thursday, May 29.

A round robin format, in brackets where necessary, will be used. Sign-ups will take place on each night of play at each division's location. Once again, no fees will be collected for these events.

Applications for the Summer League will be available April 15 and due May 15 with play beginning approximately the first week of June. Watch for bulletins in your pub/tavern for further information.

A word of personal note: During my term as Vice-President and at the beginning of my term as President, I felt one of the most important things in my life was darts. Being this the case, I chose to become involved in the daily operations of the D.D.A. because I had been a member of this association since 1975 and had never offered my help. I was not hesistant to steal precious moments of mu personal life to devote to this endeavor and at times was critical of others not willing to do so. Towards the end of the Summer League the pangs of burn-out appeared. Matters became worse as the new season wore on as several calamities and changes occurred in my personal and professional life.

Presidents letter cont'd It soon was impossible to spend those sleepless nights on D.D.A. business as my energy was put towards reorganizing my personal life. It was brought to my attention that maube the realization that there were more important things at different periods of time than darts was also taking place. I am taking the time to explain this as the changes incurred took away from the time given to you as members of the D.D.A. I want to thank those whose support was gratefully received and extend whatever apology is needed to those where needed. The season ran relatively smooth compared to other years, and I hope you will not let this discourage your future play with the D.D.A. as every effort is being made to put the D.D.A. back on track where it belongs.


