

Resident Karen Kahoopili expressed her concerns about the birds in the dining room. She said they are getting brave now. Michael shared that they are working on an automatic door similar to the one at mauka. He has met with custom builders; it is an expensive project but if they use a cheap screen (like the white ones currently being used at all lanais on the second floor back dining room and dining room areas) at the front of the building it would not look very inviting.

\*Screens in the EXR were just replaced in Oct/Nov but screens will be replaced again. It was shared that a resident continues to pop out the screens in EXR to feed the birds. There is also a bird house outside of the EXR window that is currently missing screens. Michael asked that residents discourage others from feeding the birds.

Stanley Y. suggested an interim measure (regarding birds): could servers remove express tables dining ware when returning into the kitchen? He noticed that the express tables used dining ware remains on tables for a lengthy time and birds are beginning to eat the food off the used dining ware. Michael shared that servers are short staffed and are not encouraged to remove used dining ware while serving other residents their food because of cross contamination. Server would have to wash hands in between serving and busting tables.

Inspectors-Health Department- birds are a struggle for all open dining rooms. Two types of dining rooms 1) open dining room and closed kitchen or 2) closed dining room and open kitchen. \*cannot have both

Nona Andrews expressed her thanks for shampooing carpet in dining room and hopes that it will be a regular thing. Michael shared that it will be done every 30 days including the hallways.

\*please report if you see something that needs attention.

\*please do not shut off lights in common areas. Lights are left on as a safety concern. Clear cases will be installed over the light switches.

#### Resident Concern-

-elevators needs attention

-2<sup>nd</sup> floor has a heavy smoker and sometimes smoke comes into the hallway.

\*Management cannot limit people from smoking in their rooms but can limit them from smoking in common areas. State law is 20 feet away from buildings, doorways, and windows.
