Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasite, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccination.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this match, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Dogs Eligible To Enter

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Regular and preferred heights will be run and scored together. Walk-throughs will be announced in the trial information after closing. FEO RUNS (For exhibition only) ARE OFFERED. Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. Because this is an ISC Only Event, FEO is available for every ISC run. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

FIX AND GO ON WILL BE ALLOWED

Chapter 5. Section 8. Fix and Go On. At any time during a run the handler may immediately fix a single obstacle one time. The action shall be judged as an elimination, which shall be marked as an "E" on the scribe sheet, resulting in a non-qualifying score (NQ). The handler may go back a few obstacles prior to the fix. If a jump bar (bar jump or single bar jump) is knocked, the handler may reset it, but the reset is limited to one jump bar. The dog may not be verbally or physically corrected for the error. Weave poles may be immediately re-attempted three times, but if the dog is brought back to obstacles prior to the weave poles, it will be considered the one time Fix and Go On attempt. Once handlers have used the one-time Fix and Go On option, they must immediately finish the course or exit the ring. The judge shall not judge the dog's run after the fix but will continue to watch the run to ensure that the handler is going on to complete the course correctly, is not using harsh commands or corrections and that the run is being done safely. The judge will immediately whistle to excuse the team from the ring for any of these infractions.

FEES

- Fees for Saturday and Sunday: \$20 each run, or all 6 each day for \$110 (save \$10)**

One entry form per dog may be used for all days. E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a PRINTED e-mail address on the entry form. If you need a paper confirmation and would like to know the status of your entry prior to the issuance of the judging schedule upon closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

Awards

Placement medals will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place each day for the highest cumulative score in each height (regardless of whether you are running at your regular height, preferred height, or FCI/ISC height). Additional toys/treats will also be given to winners.

Entry Requirements for International Sweepstakes Class (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<https://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC (Grade 1, 2, or 3). At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the above information may run any level. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

Jump Heights: DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

Small (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring 13-3/4" or less at the withers

Medium (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13-3/4" and up to 16-7/8" at the withers

Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16-7/8" but less than 18-7/8" at the withers.

Large (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 16-7/8" at the withers

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- Owners or handlers entering dogs in a trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and these Regulations.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat buckle or quick release collar without tags or other attachments. Choke, pinch, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Dogs must be kept on leash except when in ring or practice area.
- A small warm up area with a single practice jump will be provided. No other equipment or training devices will be allowed on the show grounds
- Entries must be received by the closing date, and in US funds. Mail early to avoid disappointment. Entries received after the closing date will be returned. If express mailing is used please sign release to be left at the door.
- Entries WILL BE REFUNDED for bitches that come into season by the trial date, with a signed notice by the dog's regular veterinarian to be verified by the club with the veterinarian before the refund is made.
- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or the club, or banned from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- No entry shall be refunded if the test cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of club.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$35 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.
- Confirmation of entries will be sent out before the trial. If you listed your e-mail address on the entry form, your confirmation will be via e-mail only.
- Fault Limits may be imposed at the discretion of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made.
- Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.
- Move-ups are allowed day to day at this trial. A move-up form must be filled out and turn in no later than the day preceding the event – i.e. if you qualify on Saturday, you need to turn in the form on Saturday before you leave.
- There will be limited parking, so please no RV's.
