FIFTH GRADE READING

The following goals are at the core of our Fifth grade curriculum. Please note that these are important goals, but they are not the only concepts to which students will be exposed at this grade level. Students will have a rich curriculum, and their experiences in reading will introduce them to many new concepts that will deepen over time.

Foundational Reading Skills

- Demonstrates skills by applying grade level phonics and word analysis.
- Reads grade level texts with accuracy and fluency to support comprehension.

Literature

- Retells grade level texts and identifies character, plot and setting.
- Uses key ideas and details to summarize and infer.
- Uses context to determine the meaning of unknown words.
- Compares and contrasts two or more characters, settings or events in a story.
- Reads and comprehends literature independently at grade level.

Informational

- Uses key ideas to summarize text and infer.
- Uses key ideas and details to determine the main idea of text and explains how it is supported by key details.
- Compares and contrasts the overall structure of events, ideas, or information.
- Uses text features to integrate knowledge and ideas.
