Pool/Recreational Facilities Rules

Individuals or Households who violate these rules or trespass are subject to: fines, 60 day suspension of pool card, and/or prosecution.

- 1. Harris Glen Park/Pool is Private Property. It is owned and maintained by the Harris Glen HOA for use by its residents and accompanied guests. Up to 4 accompanied guests allowed per household. An accompanied guest cannot be a resident of the Harris Glen HOA. Residents of the HOA must have their own key to enter the Pool. Rental of the Clubhouse will be required for more than 4 accompanied guests.
- 2. All individuals are subject to random access key and residency checks. Please be prepared to present access card and/or an ID to verify residency.
- 3. The Park and Pool are open 8AM to 9PM.
- 4. No lifeguard on duty at the Pool. No running and no diving allowed in Pool area.
- 5. Use Pool & Park at your own risk Harris Glen HOA is not responsible for any injuries or loss/damage of property that may occur.
- 6. Residents under the age 16 must be accompanied by parent or authorized guardian.
- 7. No tobacco products or vapor/e-cig products in Pool area.
- 8. No glass containers are allowed in Park or Pool area.
- 9. No alcoholic beverages are allowed at any time in the Park or Pool area.
- 10. No loud music.
- 11. No pets in Pool or in enclosed Pool area at any time.
- 12. All pets must be leashed in the Park at all times. Please clean up after your pet.
- 13. Please be considerate of other residents using the Park & Pool and especially the residents nearest the Park & Pool.
- 14. Harris Glen HOA encourages its residents to think and act "green" by walking or biking to the Park. No parking will be allowed on public streets.
- 15. Please notify HOA Board of any unsafe equipment or conditions.
- 16. The Harris Glen HOA will notify law enforcement regarding all illegal activities.
- 17. Please, always leave the Park in the same or better condition than it was originally found.
