### 1. How much is the tuition for Scoop School

The cost for the standard 3 day course is \$895.00

### 4. Can I extend to the Advanced course during Standard Course session of Scoop School?

We prefer that students research the course agenda and make an informed decision before registering for either the standard or advanced course. This is purely for catering and transport planning.

That being said, if a student decides they want to extend to the advanced course, they can pay the balance of the advanced course tuition anytime during the standard course. That balance would amount to \$500.
