What is the cancellation policy?

All registered participants are required to notify the APICS Hamilton Chapter of cancellation by sending an e-mail message to education@APICSHamilton.org with your cancellation.

Refunds will not be provided after the cancellation boundary has past. Workshop cancellations by the Chapter, due to minimums not met, will not be subject to 5% non-refundable processing fees.

Eligibility to Enroll and Authorization to Test

CLTD Workshop participants are personally responsible to attain their eligibility (i.e., to take the workshop and write the exam) from APICS which must be provided to the Chapter as part of enrollment to ensure participant's satisfactory involvement in a Supply Chain Management role.

CLTD participant exam vouchers must be converted to Authorization to Test (ATT) within six months of the workshop start date and the ATT is then valid for six months for participants to schedule and take their exam. Participants have access to online CLTD study tools for twelve months from start date of the workshop.

Participants must have a valid APICS PLUS membership to enroll in workshop and be assigned ATT vouchers to write exams. If participants do not have an APICS PLUS membership, then Workshop registration fee surcharges will apply to purchase an APICS PLUS membership and/or to uplift current membership from APICS CORE to APICS PLUS to ensure your eligibility.


