## SCHOOL DISTRICT ASKS FOR COMMUNITY INPUT

**[May 13]** Templeton Unified School District (TUSD) sent the following message out to parents and staff yesterday on behalf of Superintendent Joe Koski. All members of the community are invited/encouraged to attend and participate in the discussion.

"The San Luis Obispo County Office of Education is proposing to sub-contract with Templeton Unified to provide a limited amount of administrative time in order to develop a leadership training program to be offered across our region."

"This is a short-time proposal currently scheduled to begin on July 1, 2019 and end no later than June 30, 2020."

"If the Trustees (school board) were to approve this proposal, we would need to restructure duties at the District Office level. The Board and I would like to hear from you prior to determining a course of action."

"Please attend an informational meeting and feedback session on Thursday, May 16 from 5:15 to 6:15 pm in the School Board Room (Eagle Conference & Training Center next to the District office at 950 Old County Road)."
