

The Village of Sheridan will be starting a review of all properties within the Village to ensure compliance with the Village of Sheridan Municipal Code. In particular, the Village will be concentrating on violations included in Chapter 6- Board of Health under the section entitled Nuisance Per Se and Chapter 18- Removal of Abandoned Motor Vehicles of the Municipal Code. A copy of the Municipal Code of the Village of Sheridan can be found on our website at www.sheridan-il.us. Please review these chapters prior to the Village review which will take place early April.

The Village has received several complaints about the storage and parking of vehicles and the accumulation of garbage and/or rubbish around town and the Village wants to keep Sheridan a safe and attractive community.

The Village also has a Spring Clean Up Day scheduled for May 12, 2017 for you to be able to set your "junk" curbside for pick up!

ALL ITEMS MUST BE PLACED BY THE CURBSIDE BY 6:00A.M.



With your help we were able to raise over \$5600 for the Foreman family!!!!


