Pre-Trial entries close March 19, 2024. If trial does not fill, day of show entries will be accepted.

Total runs limited to 350 each day.

This is a one-ring agility trial, held indoors on permanent mats. Ring size is $80^{\circ} \times 108^{\circ}$. Electronic timers will be used.

Saturday 9:00 am: Low to High 2 Jumpers, 2 Gamblers, 2 Regular

Sunday 9:00 am: High to Low 2 Gamblers, 2 Regular, 2 Jumpers

Equipment: 24" weave poles, tunnels, rubber-coated, slatted dog-walk and A Frame (5ft 4in), displaceable tire, teeter, winged & non-winged jumps may be used.

ASCA agility - fast, flowing and fun!

Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA) agility offers 3 classes:

- <u>Regular</u>: Obstacles may include jumps, tire, tunnels, teeter, A-frame, dog walk and weave poles (6 for novice: 12 for open & elite). There is no table. Complete the numbered course accurately and within time.
- <u>Gamblers:</u> Accumulate points for 30 seconds by completing the obstacles in a course of your choosing.; When the buzzer sounds, complete a numbered gamble of 4-5 obstacles from a distance.
- <u>Jumpers:</u> Complete a numbered course of jumps & tunnels accurately and within time. There are no weave poles in ASCA jumpers.

ASCA agility is open to all breeds and mixes 18 months or older. Dogs 15 months or older can enter FEO (for exhibition only) and jump a lower height. No points for titles in the FEO division. You don't have to register with ASCA. If you apply for a QT number, ASCA will keep track of your qualifying scores and titles. You may start at any level: Qualifying scores will first be applied to titles for lower classes skipped. If you qualify at a higher level, you cannot go back to a lower level in that particular class.

All dogs may enter elite classes.

Refusals are not faulted. If your dog misses an obstacle, you may try again and might still qualify.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) & Training With a TOY entries are offered both days. Dogs must be 15 months of age.

ASCA allows training in the ring and the judge will explain at briefing.

Declared Toys will be allowed in the ring for training purposes.

These toys may not involve food or treats of any kind, may not make noise, or may not leave parts behind. All handlers declaring toys will mark the gate sheet with a "T" at the run check-in and will run **in order by jump height**. Upon entering the ring, handlers must declare to the judge that they have a toy. Handlers will have the specified time for training in the ring. If handlers bring a toy in the ring without declaring it, they will be asked to leave immediately.

ASCA programs of competition: Championship and ACE

- Championship (ATCH) classes- ASCA's traditional competition
 - Standard dogs
 - o Veteran dogs ≥ 7 yrs old jump 4" lower
 - Junior Handlers < 17 yrs old may jump their dogs 4" lower
- Agility Competitor Extraordinaire (ACE) Dogs jump 4" lower.
- ACE Senior dogs (> 7 YRS OLD) jump 8" lower.
- Titles: Jumpers and Gamblers you need 20 points (2 clean runs).
- Regular titles: 30 points (3 clean runs).

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This event is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America, hereinafter referred to as "ASCA". This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of the Australian Shepherd Club of America. For a complete listing of the rules, visit http://www.asca.org

TnASC, its board of directors, ASCA, and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, owners or to any of their dogs, personal property, or children.

Through submission of entry, the competitor acknowledges that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, including, but not limited to the following:

- 1. All ASCA Agility trials shall be open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.
- 2. All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA Agility Trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- 3. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the Agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in control will be excused from the Agility trial.
- 4. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial, will be reported to ASCA and may be banned from further TnASC events.
- 5. No collars, food, or toys (unless declared) will be allowed on the course. Leashes must comply with current ASCA COVID procedures.
- 6. No choke, pinch or prong collars are allowed on the trial grounds.
- 7. All dogs must be on lead or securely crated when not in the ring.
- 8. The organizing committee of this event reserves the right to refuse any entry based on suitable causes only. Anyone who is not in good standing with TnASC or ASCA will not be allowed entry.
- 9. Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks are not permitted on the trial grounds. **RELEASE:**
- 1. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves, their guests and the actions of their dogs.
- 2. All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only but may not videotape any portion of this event for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of ASCA.
- 3. Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS AND HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT TO ASCA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cable cast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known. All competitors and handlers hereby release ASCA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claims or cause of action for invasion of rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

BEHAVIOR:

- 1. Competitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs & children. Any competitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site. No refund will be made.
- 2. Handlers caught not picking up after their dog may be asked to leave the show site and no refund will be made.

Leashes: During Covid 19, exhibitors may choose to wear or pocket the leash as long as it is attached tightly or completely inside the pocket. If the leash falls out or the dog grabs the leash to play, it will be considered a toy & the run will be eliminated. ASCA assumes no responsibility if the handler chooses to wear or pocket their leash should it catch on obstacles and/or cause the handler to trip.

AWARDS:

All qualifiers will receive qualifying ribbons as well as placement ribbons for 1^{st} - 4th by jump height. Rosette and Commemorative Bar will be awarded for each team completing an ATCH. Please inform Awards Chairperson of the possibility prior to running!

HIGH IN TRIAL AWARDS:

HIT Novice, Open and Elite (eligible dogs must be entered in the same level all classes), Veteran Dog & Junior. Overall awards for HIT Aussie & HIT non-Aussie will also be presented (eligible dogs do not have to be entered in same level all classes). A HIT ACE Overall rosette will be awarded each day.

*High in Trial qualifying points are dependent on class level of qualifying scores earned. Faultless qualifying runs in each class are given the following HIT Q point values:

Elite regular = 10 points. Elite jumpers and gamblers = 7 points.

Open regular = 9 points. Open jumpers and gamblers = 6 points.

Novice regular = 8 points. Novice jumpers and gamblers = 5 points. A faulted (.01 to 5 faults) qualifying run HIT Q points: Elite 5 pts, Open 4.5 pts, Novice 4 pts.

In the event of a tie, the highest total of the YPS from all regular qualifying runs will determine the winner. The 2nd tie breaker will be the highest number of gambler points earned in qualifying rounds. In the event a 3rd tie breaker is needed it will be the dog with the highest total of YPS from all qualifying jumper rounds.

All Ribbons, Rosettes, and Prizes must be picked up by end of day Sunday. None will be mailed. All unclaimed Ribbons, Rosettes, and Prizes remain the property of the awarding club.

All dogs except those in the 20+"; Vets/Jr.H/ACE Std in the 16"+ or ACE Sr. Dogs in the 12"+ classes must show an ASCA, AKC or NADAC Height Card or be measured at trial before running.

Pre-Trial Entry & Fee Information

Entries open February 9, 2024 and close March 19, 2024. Email confirmations will be sent. Day of entries will be accepted if the trial does not fill. Dogs receiving titles after the closing date may move-up by providing the trial secretary with the owner's full name, dog's name, ASCA (or other) number, class entered and from and to level. Day to day move ups are allowed.

It is your responsibility to check your confirmation and contact the trial secretary with any corrections to avoid delays on the morning of the trial. Please contact the trial secretary if you do not receive a confirmation email.

1 - 4 runs: \$13/run 5 - 10 runs: \$12/run ≤11 runs; \$11/run
Price is based on total number of runs entered by owner, not the number of dogs. Junior Handler \$8/run regardless of total runs.

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant—or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property—sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County. Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from-among other things-claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.
