PURPOSE:

To define the District's standard procedure for disregarding members responding in personally owned vehicles (POV)

RESPONSIBILITY:

All District Personnel

PROCEDURES:

Members can be disregarded by St. Charles County Dispatch and Alarm (dispatch), the incident officer or the senior member on scene, using the following procedure:

- 1. The incident officer or senior member will notify dispatch of that there are adequate personnel on scene and any incoming units can be disregarded.
- 2. Dispatch will repeat the disregard on channels one (1) and two (2).
- 3. All personnel not on scene with their vehicle in park will immediately disable their siren and emergency lights and discontinue their response to the scene. Any member using their DSN to go responding should then put themselves "in service" over the radio.
- 4. Personnel shall go to the station, assist in placing all apparatus back in service, and report your response to the incident officer or senior member so it can be logged in the incident report.
