**AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS SERIES
CLASSROOM STRATEGIES FOR
EARLY CHILDHOOD AUTISM**

The intervention and classroom strategies presented are based on the TEACCH Model, using evidenced-based strategies to create a framework for academic curriculum and functional skill development in both self-contained and inclusive early childhood settings. The seminar focuses on understanding the characteristics of autism in early childhood, implementing curriculum and IEP goals, classroom structure, and cognitive, communication, social, and play development. Problem solving behavior will also be discussed. Participants will:

- ❖ Apply learning principles to create strategies for teaching academics, social, play and communication skills
- ❖ Use the principles of physical structure to design a classroom
- ❖ Use structure to create individualized student schedules and work systems
- ❖ Use the principles of visual organization and visual supports to promote skill development
- ❖ Use knowledge gained to problem solve student responses based on their autism traits
