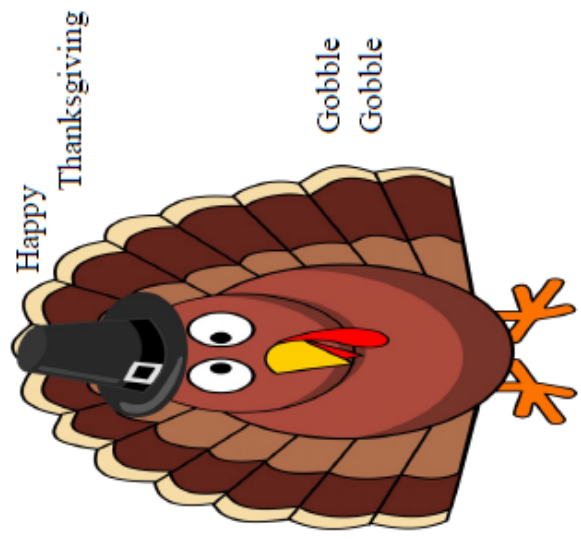

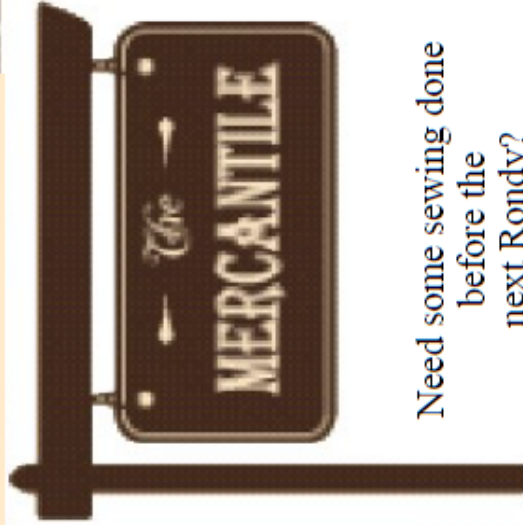

1847 Oregon Trail Sourdough Hotcakes by
Judy Meeks from "Henkle Heritage Cookbook"

The night before mix:

1/2 cup starter
1-1/4 cup water
Let sit in a warm place till morning, add:
2 eggs, beaten
1/4 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoon oil
1/2 cup flour
1 Tablespoon sugar
1/2 cup flour

Bake on a hot griddle. For waffles just add a little
more flour.

Beer Bread with Chili's and Cheese

3 cups self rising flour
1 (12oz) bottle of beer
1 sm can green chilis (minced)
6 Tablespoon butter, melted
2 Tablespoon Sugar
1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese
Grease 5 x 9 inch bread loaf pan

Mix together flour, sugar, beer, cheese and chilies
until bleanded. Pour batter into pan and spread
evenly. Pour melted butter over batter and bake in
350°F preheated oven for 50 to 60 minutes or until
toothpick comes out clean. Cool 5 minutes on
rack. Let cool 5 more minutes, slice and enjoy.
