C l e r g y C o l u m n

This Sunday (or next Sunday, depending upon the parish) we are going to start learning a new Mass setting. A Mass setting is a suite of musical pieces (all with a similar melody or style) that we sing at Mass for the Kyrie, Gloria, Sanctus, and Agnus Dei. At present we have been singing the very simple Mass of the Patriarchs and the much more elaborate Jubilation Mass. We are going to learn the Mass setting that is printed in the Roman Missal (the book from which the priest gets all the words and prayers of the Mass). This setting is considered the default Mass setting. It is a Mass setting that every English-speaking Catholic anywhere in the world ought to know. This Mass setting is adapted from the default Mass setting that is found in Missals which are printed in Latin, the official language of our Church, and this Mass setting is based on the melodies of Gregorian Chants which were first sung around 1800 years ago. The Mass setting from the Roman Missal is written in a minor key, which is why I think it will be great to use this as our Mass setting in the penitential seasons of Lent and Advent. We are going to start learning it now, while there is still time to learn the Gloria before the start of Lent, and I am sure we will take it out and dust it off occasionally throughout the course of the year.
