Henry "Harry" Wieszbicki, 86, of Rapson, formerly of Harbor Beach, died Thursday, Feb. 21, 2002, at the Huron Medical Center in Bad Axe. He was born Sept. 29, 1915, in Parisville, son of the late Paul and Martha (Gwisdalla) Wieszbicki. He married Mary Sanderson. She preceded him in death.
