With the church opening up under Alert Level 2 guidelines, we are not permitted to pass around the collection plate. If you drop your envelopes at the office door, please ring the doorbell to notify Helen at the office that it is there so she can pick up immediately. **Please refrain from depositing at the office door outside of office hours.**

Recycling Fundraiser
