FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Good morning and welcome to Immanuel Baptist Church. We are pleased you are here to worship with us this morning. Last week was a very special Sunday for our church family as we celebrated our 10th anniversary of this church family. We also were treated to a wonderful lunch by the Kitchen Committee and all of the folks who helped prepare, decorate, serve and clean-up. Thank you all for a very special time.

After all, if this were not true, the Bible would be unreliable, Christ would not be divine, and His death on the cross would not atone for our sins. But we know it is true.
