Backhousia citriodora

Wattleseed is wild harvested. Roasted whole and ground. Contains three microelements important for genome health: magnesium (Mg(, zinc (Zn) and calcium (Ca). As well as rich sources of iron (Fe) and having a high protein level approx 17%, carbohydrate 41%, fibre 29%, fat 3 % .(Brand & Cherikoff 1985) and a low GI average 1480+270 KJ /100gms (Brand & Maggire 1992)

Applications:

Most of today's uses are based around making a roasted hazel nutty flavor from the seed. By roasting the raw wattle seed until it pops, similar to pop corn. This new unique flavor has many uses, coffee-like beverages (caffeine free), essences, beer, baking, confectionery, dairy and marinades.

Over the past few years even the pod/husk of Wattleseed - (Acacia victoriae) have been researched for its medical properties, in the fight
