Ralston's Annual July 3rd Pie Baking Contest

Pies are judged on:

Outside appearance: crust – is it homemade?

Inside appearance: crust, filling and flavor

Overall appearance: presentation

Pie Guidelines:

1. Categories: Fruit and Other
2. Enter pies in nonreturnable tin. Pies in glass are not accepted.
3. No cream, meringue, refrigerated/frozen pies accepted.
4. Pies must have a crust (brownies baked in a pie tin is not a pie)
5. Store bought crusts are scored lower.

If the guidelines are not followed, your pie will **NOT be judged.**

All pies must be at Ralston Park (80th & Park Drive)

by 4PM in order to be judged.
