## SATURDAY, MARCH 1ST, 2025


- Will stop for breakfast before entering park.

- One Meal Voucher provided





## WHAT TO PACK

- Suitcase

# ON BUS WITH STUDENTS

### FIRST DAY BAG (CARRY ON) Phone/Charger/Portable Battery

  - Any drinks must be able to be closed (no cans/cups...this includes energy drinks)
- Money
- Water Park Clothes/Supplies (on next slide)
- First day toiletries
  - Deodorant (please)
  - Feminine hygiene products
  - Toothbrush/Toothpaste
  - Hairbrush
  - Contacts/Solution/Glasses

#### **POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

#### LUGGAGE AND PACKING

- All luggage and instruments must be labeled with the traveler's name, address, and phone number (use the proved luggage tags)
- Large instruments will go under the bus. Small instruments (flute/clarinet) will go in overhead compartments. Don't forget your music.
- Only 1 Suitcase Must have luggage tag
- 1 Carry-on Must have luggage tag


#### DEPARTURE

## STUDENT -CHAPERONE-DIRECTOR CONTACT

- We will be using the BAND app to communicate with students throughout the trip. This is a popular app for managing large student organizations and providing quick updates for students when travelling.
- Students are not able to message directors/staff directly.
- Has cool functions, like a shared band photo album for students collecting/sharing trip photos.



# **BUS POLICIES AND**

#### PROCEDURES

- Chaperones and equipment crew will load the bus first, followed by reverse class order (seniors, then juniors, etc.)
- No students will be allowed to switch buses for any reason.
- Student seating may be reassigned by staff/chaperones for disciplinary reasons
- All music must be played through earphones
- Any videos played on bus televisions must be rated G or PG and may be vetoed by the staff.

 Videos, moves, and pictures on student cell phones/tablets should adhere to school policy. Obscene or profane material will be treated as if on school property. Drinks must be in containers that can be sealed. No cans or cups. • No sunflower seeds. Opposite gender students and couples cannot sit together on the bus. • For your comfort, please refrain from using the restrooms on the bus unless absolutely necessary. No # 2's.

## HOTEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Students are absolutely not allowed in the room of an opposite gender student or in any other room
- Couples must not be in a room alone. This is a very quick way to have major disciplinary action taken
- Students may not leave rooms after lights out and the chaperone has checked the room. THIS INCLUDES GOING TO GET ICE OR THE VENDING MACHINE.
- Each night and morning the room will be checked by a chaperone/staff member.
- Do not be loud in your hotel rooms or act foolish in the common areas.
- You are advised not to stay up all night or you will be miserable. We have very early
  mornings and late nights. You will be exhausted. Students have gotten sick in the past
  from not getting rest and being hydrated. This causes chaperones, directors, and
  students to take care of these students and ruins the fun.

#### BREAKFAST AND WAKE-UP

- Every student must be at breakfast. This is where we make sure everyone is awake and ready to go, and it's from breakfast where we load the buses.
- The wake up time is the absolute latest time to be awake. Chaperones/staff will come by around this time and distribute medications if needed and make sure everyone is awake.
- If you are late, you make everyone else late. People paid a lot of money to come on this trip, so please don't waste anyone's time by being late in the mornings

#### PARK POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Upon receiving your ticket, take a picture of the front and back of it on your phone. If you lose your ticket you have to go to costumer service and wait in line for a new ticket but you MUST have proof. AKA: DON'T LOSE YOUR Ticket!!!
- Your room chaperone is your assigned chaperone at the parks.
- Students will check in with their chaperones throughout the day. This may happen in a couple different ways:
- Proof of life selfies/text messages (selfies are good because it shows where you're at) Meeting times before different events (like leaving a park or going to dinner) • Students are typically not required to stay with a chaperone at all times, but must check in. Students must never be alone in the park; they must use the buddy system. Some reasons that may cause a student to stay with a chaperone include:
  - Tardiness
  - Being alone in the park
  - Violation of park rules
  - Violation of school rules
- Or any other reason determined appropriate by a staff member. Students may go freely between Islands of Adventure, Universal Studios, and City Walk, but students must text their chaperone when they switch parks.

#### DRESS CODE AND CONDUCT

- Students should remember that they are representing Mandeville High School at all times.
- Clothing should not be too revealing or have offensive/inappropriate/vulgar/profane language or imagery
- Tank tops are okay. If a student is asked to change they need too.
  Students and chaperones should refrain from wearing political attire (in alignment with
- Students and chaperones should refrain from wearing STPSB policies)
- Students should refrain from using profane/vulgar language, especially when in public.
  Students must show respect to, and follow the directives of, all chaperones and staff
- Students must show respect to, and follow the directive members.
