Barnes & Noble and the PTSA will have a table of books set up at registration. All major credit cards, cash and checks made out to Barnes & Noble will be accepted. B&N Members will need to allow us to calculate the final price, with Member discount, at point of sale.

At Tesoro we emphasize reading both in and out of the classroom. The English Department requires the reading of literary texts at each grade level and in each class to assist students in meeting the goals of our curriculum and to instill a lifelong habit of reading. The books for each class are CUSD Board approved. These texts will take our students on journeys outside of their current boundaries where they will explore foreign lands, different cultures, the devastating effects of war, dystopian worlds, the Elizabethan era, Ancient Greece, and eras from America's past.

We encourage students to procure personal copies of our study texts if possible so that they may practice annotating skills while completing the assigned reading. By highlighting and making notations in the margins of these texts, students gain a deeper insight into the intentions of the author and can explore their own reactions to the novel. They can search for literary devices, highlight themes and motifs, underscore character traits, and recognize rhetorical devices. The skills they practice through annotation will provide them with a thorough understanding of the text as well as give them valuable skills for the future.

For these reasons, we are working with Barnes & Noble and the PTSA to provide these texts for purchase during our registration this summer. **(Please note that buying these books is NOT a requirement. The library provides these texts to the students free of charge; however, students may not annotate books provided by the school.)**

Purchasing these books from Barnes & Noble provides funds for the Tesoro Library to enhance our library catalog and improve technology for Tesoro students.
