






If you are ready to return early let us know and we will try to return you early. If you are not going to be ready on time please try to call in advance of your pick up time so that the driver won't have to come back twice.</p> <p>Transportation for Somers seniors and disabled passengers to their appointments and other destinations in Somers, Enfield and Stafford. Medical appointments take priority and in case of bad weather the bus follows the Town of Somers school system delay and/or cancellation schedule.</p> <p>If you are looking for transportation to a Doctor appointment, dialysis, haircut, shopping or even bingo, please give us a call at the Senior Center @ 763-4379 at least 2 days in advance if possible, and they will be happy to add you to their daily schedule.</p> <p>In the case of inclement weather you can get cancellation information by watching WFSB Channel 3.
