Therefore, I think the great majority of people living absolutely in the material, as we did, and denying the existence of anything spiritual, as we did, are not so much to be blamed for their ignorance as they are to be pitied for their grotesque misinterpretations of spiritual things.

My spiritual enlightenment has been a very long slow story, beginning as I now remember in 1868 when I heard of a spiritualist healing a very bad case of catarrh of the nasal passages. I think this was the first time I got the idea that there

could be life outside of material. Since that I have studied a host of "sciences" and "isms", spiritualism, new thought, yoga philosophy, theosophy, etc, ad

DEMONOLOGY or IN MY NAME SHALL YE CAST OUT DEVILS

Sermon by
CHAS. F. PARHAM
As Preached in the Armory Hall,
Roswell, New Mexico.

This subject, scarcely ever touched upon by modern preachers, has become one of the most engrossing subjects for study. Covering the largest field of investigation of any subject before the world today. The meaning of the word Demonology, signifies the power of evil spirits upon the lives and characters of the human race. The Bible strictly teaches that we are to be able through the power of God to rise above all demon forces into companionship with Jesus, and to become a medium for the Holy Spirit. Most people today are controlled by one or more spirit forces, which are not of God. Many people say, "Oh, there is no devil", or that the devil is dead, but, if he is dead, he has left a splendid Administrator who is carefully looking after all his heirs. For surely the children of the devils kingdom are getting all that is coming to them. Again the question is asked, "Where did the devil come from?" According to the best records available, in the dawn of creation, when the morning stars sang together, and God took counsel with the Son and Holy Spirit as to the creation of the universe, the heavenly hosts of angels were under the control or leadership of four archangels known as Gabriel, Michael, Uriel and Lucifer, or Satan; the latter being the angel of light and controlled a quarto of the angels of heaven. When the God-head had created man an edict was issued that the angels of heaven should pass before the creation of God, or man, and bow in acknowledgment of the handiwork of God. Gabriel and his angels passed, Michael and his angels passed, Uriel and his angels passed, and following their leaders each one bowed, but Lucifer, being lift. ed up in pride, determined not to obey the order and bow to a creature whom he considered of lesser origin than himself, failed to bow, his followers participating in his disobedience, and for this rebellion against the known command

of God, satan and his angels were cast the heavenly city. Henceforth, to war upon the human race who were the cause of their fall. With him were cast out some of the mightiest creatures of God's dominion. Creatures of vast intelligence, of supernatural power, perhaps even with some creative ability. One of their number is afterwards said to have resisted Gabriel as a prince of Persia, so that Gabriel was unable to get to Daniel with the answer to his prayer for twenty one days. The superb, intellectual creatures are the inspirers and organizers of all modern religious and reform movements that do not teach the regeneration of the inner man. For all movements religious or otherwise engaging the at tention, interesting in an organized way, and wasting the money of vast numbers of the human race today are inspired of the devil. Any religious or reform movement however beautiful or grand in ideals and principles that do not teach the re-generation, the inward spiritual birth are inspired of these fallen spirits, and such movements will be of no lasting benefit to the human race. All great ministers, lecturers and evangelists of the day are teaching less than an old fashioned know so conversion, are inspired of these forces. They surround these religious leaders and evangelists with myriads of spirits, creating a religious mania imitating the real power of the Holy Spirit. Once while in Chicago a question was hurled at me from the audience, "What will be the primary or fundamental cause in the overthrow of the present civilization?" As quick as a flash the answer came by inspiration to me. All this murder, revolutionary unrest and murderous savage tendencies result from this one fact, that the majority of the children born into this world today are unwanted and hated, and against whom murder is thought, if not practised before they were born; which results in their being born with murder in their hearts with a tendency to kill; on which these demonized forces work, resulting in murders, and with the organizing power of these fallen angels, resulting in the world being filled with all manner of radical movements, threatening the overthrow of our civilization, the destruction of all government and the wiping out of the christian religion, paving the way for the reign of the Anti Christ." "Gentlemen," I said, "The answer to your question is this, The overthrow of civilization will follow the law of retribution, the unwanted, hated, undesired children of these social and religious systems of today will turn back upon these institutions and wreck them, because, they are the undesired offspring of our present civilization." again I reiterate, the study of demonology enters into every detail great or small, affecting the smallest details of the home life, reaching through all the affairs of the human race, social, religious, educational, judicial, and affecting even the future of our civilization.

In connection with the work of these fallen giants of the spiritual realm, multitudes of demons, their origin is entirely unknown, but their existence is an absolute certainty, are under the order, control and dominion of these fallen angels. They are used in a devastating way upon the human race, feeding upon the mind in insanity and nervous disorders and all manner of criminal and evil propensities, upon the body in all manner of afflictions and diseases, upon the passion in all manner of abnormal, unlicensed ruination of the human race. So great are the effects of these fallen spirits with their demon aids, that doctors and criminologists and numbers of preachers are making exhaustive studies of their effect and inroads upon the human race. Until, today, nearly all the damning forces that beset humanity can be directly chargeable to spirit or psychological forces.

The physicians in medical journals for twenty years have been writing articles upon the psychological forces in diseases, attributing at least half of the afflictions of the human race to psychic or spirit force and have introduced suggestive therapeutics or hypnotism, to combat these psychic forces. Seeking by the power of hypnotism to eliminate or drive out of the patient the demonozed force that torments him. The fact is, that half of the diseases that the human race has are imaginary, and exist only in the mind of the individual who has nursed certain symptoms and allowed their mind to dwell upon supposed symptoms until they have actually assumed afflicted conditions. A bilious disposition reflects itself upon the physical; the liver fails to perform its proper function, failing to furnish the proper secretions to digest the food in the stomach. The food sours without digesting, creating a gas that affects the heart, resulting in a seeming serious condition, which really is only the grouch; this is an example of many things that affect the human race. Suggestive hypnotism. Christian Science and Coue-ism are valuable aids in relieving these immaginary afflictions. If the human race would throw back their shoulders and face the world with a smile and cheerful disposition, half of the afflictions would disappear.

Secondly, half of the afflictions of the human race are not diseases at all, but demonized torments that feed upon the body in various diseases, so that it is said of Jesus, that "he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick." Mat. 8:16-17, and it is still within the province of ministry to obey the commission of Jesus Christ, Mark 16:17, to cast out devils, and thus relieve the human race by the power of God of half of their afflictions, which would cause the human race to flow into the hill of the Lord and serve the true and the living God; for the casting out of devils and the healing of the sick is the most potent power in the evangelization of the world today. So that coupled with medical testimony which is in agreement with the word of God upon this subject, all such diseases as cancers, tumors, consumption, catarrah, rheumatism, all fevers, epilepsy, fits and spasms, whooping cough, St Vitus dance, insanity and all nervous disorders are the direct result of tormenting The failure on the part of modern demons. ministers who pray for the sick to accomplish greater results than they do, resulting in thousands returning from great healing meetings uncured and sometimes even worse, is,

that they have aroused the demon force but not driven it out; for unless the minister praying for the sick has God given authority to cast out devils, diseases may be healed under his prayers, but demons will not be cast out, resulting in seeming failures in Divine Healing, which is not a failure, but simply resolves itself into the fact that the minister did not have the power to cast out devils. The destructive or decaying power of all diseases is directly attributable to the feeding of demons. One woman in Chicago having a cancer which ate or absorbed over a pound of raw beef steak laid upon it each day.

Criminologists working in conjunction with the Courts of America, have brought the judiciary of the country to see and believe that nearly all criminals are devil driven. A person born with any propensity or with any criminal instinct will be seized upon by criminal spirits and driven in the commission of crime, so that courts have appointed experts to determine how much psychological forces entered in to. the commission of certain crimes. Such a case is represented by the Leopold-Loeb murder of the Frank boy in Chicago. The criminologists decided that these boys through prenatal influences inherited weaknesses upon which demons working had caused them to commit this crime. Scores of criminals of all kinds, have come to us after hearing the above statements. confessing that they were criminals, many with prison records who are unable to control the propensities and asked for deliverance. They were graciously and marveously delivered. A young man in Missouri killed a beggar by the wayside without any cause, he was a brilliant young man; just before he was hanged he said he hoped in the coming days some scientist would discover the reason why he as well as others had always wanted to kill something. That he had loved to strangle chickens and ducks and kill kittens, etc., when he was a child. In after years an aged physician told how that this young man's mother had sought his aid in the destruction of this child's life before it was born, so that she might make a trip abroad and engage in her social functions; the result was, the child was born with murder in his heart. Permitting the demon forces to drive him into the commission of crime. I could give pages of testimonials from those who have been delivered from spirits of murder

and suicide and many other criminal forces.

Tolstoy, the great socialist of Russia, declared that it was a relic of barbarism and a disgrace to christianity, the way in which criminals were now punished; for these creatures were thrown in jails and dungeons, their bodies horribly punished and tortured for something that a spirit force inside of them caused them to do. "Where," he says, "Are the followers of "Thrist who should have power to cast out these levils and save the wreckage?"

Ella Wheeler Wilcox, that woman who could take a pen and dip it in ink and write in words of living flame against the double standard for male and female, and the treatment of that poor creature the female who steps aside from the path of virtue compared with that of the male, wrote a very beautiful poem, the substance of which was this: that this so called christian civilization took criminals, demon driven and placed them behind iron bars and gray stone walls causing all manner of torture of body and mind to creatures who were totally irresponsible, devil driven. "These", she said, "should rather be placed in comfortable hospitals, built on, sightly hills, overlooking natures vast extent or glimpse of the oceans blue, and under the care and guardianship of diciples of Christ who had power to cast out devils, who under their ministry could be fully delivered and restored to their families as useful mem. bers of society." To all this we fully agree. Because all such poor unfortunate creatures are the result of demonized control.

Habits, appetites, passions and lusts are fed upon by these demon powers, driving the poor unfortunate into abnormal gratifications ruining body, mind and soul. Drunkards, harlots, dope fiends, all manner of unfortunates who are ruined by habits and passions drifting through the land, subject to all manner of abuse, ridicule and torture are the unfortunate creatures controlled by demons; suffering all manner of agony and torture and abuse beth. cause demons are holding high carnival in their lives. It is time that the ministry of the Gospel should exercise their God given rights in the deliverance of these poor creatures laid at their door full of sores for whom even the modern ministry have not even the crumbs to relieve their suffering and misery. The tobacco habit: You use tobacco six months and then it will use you. If God had intended the human

race to use tobacco he would have put a smoke stack on their head and a draft in the back of it. Users of tobacco will tell you that he can quit it any time he wants to, but the old fool never does.

Nicotine has painted a yellow streak down his back. Scores of thousands are killed annually by this habit. Materia Medica and other means are not available for his deliverance. He is hopelessly doomed unless he turns to God. I have seen the power of God instantly kill the nicotine in a man's system and change his taste so that he abhorred the smell, even, of the filthy weed. Poor drunkards and harlots of the street, dope fiends, have been led to our alters, the demons driven out, their soul set free and saved and fully delivered from the powers that had beset them. Praise the Lord!

All manner of disposition evidenced by so many professed christians, which are wholly inconsistent with a christian life, can be traced to the operation of demon forces; who leap upon the unsuspecting christian and cause them to act and say or do many things that causes those about them to doubt their christian experience, so that worrying and fretting and stewing and nagging, and backbitting and scandal monging with many other nasty things, are the forces of Satan operating against christians, seemingly making the Gospel of Jesus Christ of none effect. But people often say, "How can demon forces operate upon christians?" Well, unless your whole body, soul and mind have been fully redeemed and kept under the blood of Jesus Christ these forces can enter, lay siege and often defeat you in your best purposes and determinations to live a christian life.

All nervous disorders, including insanity, are the result of tormenting demons; insane people are usually as sane as anyone else, but fiver great financial, religious or family trouoles, the person becomes so overwrought, and spirit forces enter upon the highly magnetized mind, gain control of the mind and body, causing them to do and say all the terrible, awful, pitiful things that are seen and heard in the asylums. We have had some of the most remarkable cures from the inmost recesses of incurable wards of which I could give you the names and you could get the testimonies of remarkably cured individuals, who show no evi-

dence of ever having been under the devastating influence of insanity.

These fallen angels with all their genius and ability are well nigh wrecking the modern ministry. Leading modern ministers from fundamentalism to modern, inspiring them with high and mighty phraseology, and beautiful inspired imagery and oratory, weaving most entrancing ideals, but failing to secure a positive change of heart and nature in an old fashioned conversion, and on top of all this, half the ministers of today are preaching evolution; which denies the Bible story of creation, and if there were no creation, there would have been no fall, and no necessity for a Redeemer, thereby, striking the most cowardly and dastardly blow at all the claims made by Jesus Christ and is the most Anti Christian attack ever made upon the church of the living God. And this comes mainly not from without, but from within the supposed household of faith. Every where we go they tell us that they can keep the children in Sunday school as long as they are in the grades, but as soon as they enter the High schools and begin to hear the scientific facts?? concerning evolution they lose the fear of God, their faith and confidence in God, and turn unlicensed to petting parties, immorality and every worldly thing. We are facing the greatest attack upon the foundations of christianity ever known. But we welcome the fight. Half the preachers, almost all the newspapers, the moving pictures, high schools, colleges and universities, have arrayed themselves on the side of this anti-christian move. Brethern; let the church awake. Our boasted system of public schools and universities which have been the pride of American greatness have become pagan temples in which they are undermining the faith of our youth in the word of God, thus destroying the faith of God and unless we awake and a tremendous revival which will heave the church of the living God out of its dead easy calm, into a storm of service for the Master, a deliverance from its hypocrisy, and an exiling of these professionl monkeyfied preachers to the jungles of Africa where they can educate their ancestors, our cause is lost. And we as parents will live to see the day when our children will rise up and mock at every. thing sacred and laugh at our faith in a true and living God. For what they teach in the schools of today will be the thought of tomorrow. Education that fails to teach the fear of God, leading to gross immorality, destroying the sacredness of true marriage, the loss of christian ideals among our young people, will destroy all the foundation stones upon which we have built the superstructure of our civilization. Causing the nations to fall precipituously, in a state of anarchy, leading to immediate sayagry and barbarism.

All false religions, cults teaching strange and peculiar delusions, fanaticisms, foolish, ridiculous, nonsensical, idiotic, insane performances such as are often viewed in holy roller meeting and like cults, these strange looking religious nuts which wander about the country of which southern California and especially Los Angeles seems to be the hot bed, or the incubator, are all pitiful objects of demonized control. And yet, these poor creatures suppose they are under angelic or Holy Spirit control. It is one of the most surprising things to really find a well balanced thorough going spiritual man or woman, who can stand perpendicular for God, keep their equilibrium, and evidence sanctified common sense in their religious services. There was no demonized force or spirit control in the old fashioned intense enthusiastic service of God. For the Holy Spirit never absolves us from the use of common sense and good judgment in all of our religious activities. There is quite a difference between shouting under the power of God, and screaming under spirit forces, or dancing a beautiful two step before the Lord like David and Miriam did, and this demonized jelly wobbling, shimmy side show dancing stuff pulled off today and laid on God. A difference between intense sanctified enthusiasm in the service of God and uncontrollable hysterical actions superinduced by spiritualistic-hypnotic forces to bring ridicule upon the work of God. The fact is my brethern, that God wants us to take the middle of the road in a sane, intense, enthusiastic fight for the restoration of Apostolic faith and power, leaving modernism with all its devil invented schemes and monkeyfied ancestry undermining the foundations of christianity on the one side and wild fires and fanaticism, delusions and holy rollerism on the other side. With banners unfurled with martialled step, with faces drawn in pity, with power to heal the sick and cast out devils, and bringing a message of old time salvation, girth the world with this Everlasting Gospel, closing the age in appealing tones of thunder, then with glory reflected, welcome back the King, the Prince of Peace.

WORK ON JORDON WILL BE STARTED THIS YEAR.

London, May 28.—The work on the Jordon for the purpose of utilizing the water power of the river for the electrification and irrigation of Palestine will commence this year, according to a statment made by Lord Arnold, the under-Secretary of the British Colonial office, in the House of Lords today.

The concession to this enterprise is held by Engineer Phineas Rutenberg of the World Zionist Organization, and the sum of \$1,000,000 necessary for the beginning of the work has already been raised, Lord Arnold states. The land and the necessary machinery for the enterprise have already been acquired. The sum of approximately \$4,000,000 will be necessary before the work is completed.

One electric power station is already functioning successfully at Jaffa. The Jaffa Electric Company and the concession on the Jordan, Lord Arnold stated, are "the greatest attempts ever made to develop the natural resources of Palestine."

The High Commissioner, Sir Herbert Samuel, has reported that the Jaffa Electric Company is working to the satisfaction of the consumers. Even the Arab municipality of Jaffa and private Arab citizens are using the electric power of the station.

Progress has also been made on the Jordan; the engineering plans have been submitted to the Colonial office and have been approved by the Consulting Engineer. Some delay has been caused in the carrying on of the electrificant work by the claim of the Greek engineer, Namaromatis, who says that he holds a similar concession from the Turkish government, granted when Palestine was under the rule of Turkey.

The power house in Haifa, however, is expected to start its service next year. The orders for the necessary machinery have been placed in England, and some of the machinery has already arrived in Palestine. In Jerusalem, the plan will begin functioning shortly.

TO REBUILD THE SYNAGOGUS WHERE SAVIOR PREACHED

The Ruined Temple Where Jesus Drove The Devil Out of the "Man Possessed" To Be Reconstructed Exactly As It Was In His Time.

The very synagogue which once resounded to the voice of Jesus the very stones on which He walked, have recently been discovered near the Sea of Galilee. When the building is reconstructed it will be one of the most interest ing edifices in the world, for it is the only building that has ever been found in all the centuries that scholars have been searching for sacred relics in the Holy Land in which Christ preached His gospel in person.

The ruins were unearthed by the expedition sent out from the School of Archaeology at Jerusalem, in the little town of Capernaum, at the northern end of the Sea of Galilee, and Jesus preached there, not once, but many times. Some of His most momentous utterances were made within its walls and several of His miracles were performed there.

The building was destroyed by an earthquake and the stones and pillars were deeply buried in the earth. But the dry, sandy soil has preserved them through the centuries practically intact. Now that they have been dug up it will be possible to replace them exactly as they were originally, and to reproduce the building exactly as it was when Jesus preached inside it. It is believed by many scholars that the earthquake which destroyed the Capernaum synagogue was the one describ ed in the Bible as taking place at the time or the Crucifixion. If that is true—and there is a mass of evidence indicating that it is—the building becomes even more important as a material and tangible substantiation of the gospel records. And if it was destroyed in that momentous upheaval, the synagogue stood only two years after Christ last preached in it.

It will be a comparatively easy task to rebuild the synagogue because while all the walls and columns are thrown down, the foundations and the bases of the columns are still intact.

The building was rather large, as buildings went in those days. It was fifty four feet wide and seventy five feet deep. There are no less than three entrances on the south side, which faced the Sea of Galilee. So it was, for its time, quite a stately structure.

Its interest for students of the Scriptures is deepened because it was at a turning point in Christ's life that He first preached at Capernaum. Thus it was in this synagogue, which will now stand again exactly as it was centuries ago, that Christ made His real beginning as a leader of men. Probably there is no building in all the world which has been the scene of

happenings of such tremendous moment to mankind.

There is a belief on the part of the superstitious inhabitants of the region that the ruins are cursed and that some dire misfortune will befall any one instrumental in reconstructing them. They believe that the "unclean spirits", which were exercised inside it have hovered about the place through all the centuries and that they will haunt it and cast an evil spell upon any one who may at this late date venture inside the doors. However, that will not deter the thousands of visitors to the Holy Land from entering it, and reverently, in their fancy, reconstructing the momentous happenings. Undoubtedly the little synagogue will attract more visitors each year than any other one spot in Palestine.

There can be little doubt as to the authenticity of the synagogue, for its architecture plainly dates from the first century. And it has been noted that on one large block is carved a representation of a pot of manna. Also on one of the capitals is carved the sacred seven branched candelabra, and this symbol was only placed on the synagogue. The golden original of it, which was copied throughout Palestine was in the temple at Jerusalem. This removes any doubt there might be that the newly discovered ruins are those of the synagogue, and it is not probable that there were two synagogues in a town so small as Capernaum. So it is certain that this is the building in which Jesus spoke.

Probably no descovery in years has given such direct confirmation of the gospel stories. And also it helps greatly in understanding the conditions under which Jesus lived and worked. Many have supposed that the Jews had only one place of worship, the great temple of Herod at Jerusalem. But finding the synagogue makes it certain that there were many synagogues, probably one in every city and town, in Palentine.

It is strange that of all the synagogues in which Christ spoke this one at Capernaum is the only one that has ever been found. For it was this building that was His favorite.

The entire religious world, both Jewish and Christian, is, therefore, tremendously interested in the work that is going on at Capernaum. Already the mound in which the ruins were found, called by the Arabs Tell-Hum, has been

dug down to the bottom, which was a difficult undertaking, because the mound was half a mile long and a quarter of a mile wide. It was in the center of this mound that all the columns and stones from the walls of the synagogue were found in their surprisingly perfect state of preservation. No one can guess what new light may be thrown upon Christ's life and the conditions under which he worked when all of the ruins are examined and their inscriptions deciphered and the many engravings on them interpreted. It is even possible that there may be some records found which were written while Christ Himself was alive, which would throw new light upon His thought and His life. If so, this excavation would prove of incalculable value.

But even as it is, the finding of the building itself helps tremendously to establish the credibility of the story as set forth in the New Testament.

A GREAT CATACLYSM PREDICTED

The world is destined to witness a cataclysm comparable only to the great deluge of Noahs time.

One third of the surface of the earth will crumble under the sea. A new continent will arise, probably where the South Sea Islands are. Japan, China, parts of southern Asia most of the countries of Europe, Northern Africa, and portions of land in Artic circle will disappear under water. The toil of life will be stupendous. Thus summarizes the words of Dr. Milton A. Nobles, "A prophet of earthquakes," whose predictions of the great Japanese earthquake and other Cataclysms have been startlingly verified.

SEISMOLOGICAL SOCIETY HEAD SAYS DEVASTATING QUAKE WILL VISIT COAST IN NEXT 10 YEARS

Mountains of northern California move steadily, though slowly, southward, Mountains of southern California move steadily, and perhaps a little more rapidly, northward.

This takes place because the earth is in a condition of elastic strain, such that there is a slight earthquake every day or two, as recorded by the seismograph at Mt. Wilson, near Pasadena.

"These conditions," says Dr. Bailey Willis, president of the Seismological Society of America and professor emeritus of geology at Stanford, "all agree in leading seismologists to expect the strain will be relieved by a general earthquake or by a series of local ones sconer or later.

"Any seismologist would be surprised if 10 years go by without an earthquake in southern California greater than the recent Santa Barbara quake."

If history repeats itself, Dr. Willis believes the section will experience a heavy shake within seven years.

An earthquake will be felt only incidentally farther north, Dr. Willis explains. In 1857, the quake did little damage north of San Juan Batiste. In 1906, when San Francisco was leveled, San Juan Batiste again marked the point beyond which the earth remained still.

While an earthquake can easily do serious damage, Dr. Willis urges better building construction and a simple personal precaution against bodily injury.

Buildings can be so tied together that insurance against movements of the earth is hardly necessary.

"The last relieving shock was most severe at Fort Tejon in Tehechipi," says Dr. Willis in recounting the possibilities of damage from earthquakes and how to prepare for safety, "but the entire region from Yuma to San Luis Obispo felt a strong shock.

"Los Angeles was shaken with an intensity which would do considerable damage in carelessly-built sections of a modern city.

No one knows when such a shock may come again. There have been local earthquakes during the last seven years at San Jacinto, Eisi-

nore, Inglewood and Santa Barbara. All these have been of a superficial character, and are regarded by seismologists as indications of a general pressure, but not as relieving shocks.

"If that estimate is correct, the deeper and more widely distributed strain will have to be relieved sooner or later.

"Under these circumstances every property owner will do well to see that buildings are so tied together that they can't be shaken apart, so braced that they will not be wrecked to pieces and that such things as chimneys are made strong by angle irons.

"People have a notion that tall buildings are particularly dangerous, but this is a mistake. The large class-A buildings are necessarily built of a steel frame and, more important, they vibrate during an earthquake in such a way that they resist the lateral motion of the earth more securely than low buildings.

"But the most dangerous structures are apartment houses and similar buildings up to a height limit of 150 feet, or thereabouts because of their concrete and brick walls and wood floor joists, with cheap design and poor materials and construction."

Panic causes more damage than poorly constructed buildings, Dr. Willis believes. If on feeling an earthquake shock, you quietly step into a doorway and stay there until you count 60 seconds, the earthquake will be over and your skin safe.

And if you add less than one per cent to the cost of your dwelling to provide safety bracings, your home will withstand a severe shaking.

GARY BACK FROM DIVINE HEALING TRIUMPHS IN CHILI

The Rev. O. J. Gary, brother of Elbert H. Gary, Chairman of the United Steel Corporation, has returned here from an eighteen months visit to Chili where He said He met with great success in Divine healing among the natives.

Asked to explain His methods of healing, Mr. Gary who has been a Methodist Clergy for forty one years said: I anointed them with oil and prayed over them, they are cured by the Power of God. It is prayer and Faith that relieves them of their ills.

NEW HEALING SECT APPEARS

"Full Gospellers" Attract Much Attention With Campaign In Wales.

London, Aug. 1.—Claiming that illness and physical infirmities are being cured by anointing, a new sect, calling themselves the Full Gospellers, are attracting much attention in North Wales, where they are conducting a "recruiting" and healing campaign.

The leader of the sect is Walter Wakefield, a retired Manchester business man, and many stories are told and vouched for by residents of Old Colwyn and district. "We believe in anointing for healing and baptism by immersion," declared Wakefield, who also conducts "healing services" in sick rooms.

Relatives of a man named Roberts, who was so crippled he had been unable to walk for four years, testify to a "cure" effected by Wakefield. After a service at the invalid's bedside and anointing the limbs Wakefield walked round the room reciting prayers and Robert's general health showed immediate improvement.

Among other cases mentioned locally is that of a woman, said to have been suffering from tuberculosis who claims to have been completely restored to health by the spiritual ministration of Wakefield. Baptisms in the sea off Old Colwyn have attracted considerable attention and Wakefield declares there will be many more such ceremonies as new converts are anxious to testify their faith in the most public manner.

recipient of such present for exchange for something more desirable, and the jeweler finds that his price has been marked up presumably by the giver, and the recipient of such present wants in exchange from the jeweler, a present of value corresponding with the marked up price.

We feel at this time of the year that we ought to more or less cut relatives, let them wait, while we go out with hearts filled with love and hands filled with useful presents, to impress upon those to whom these are given, that we do it in the name of Jesus, that they may turn to Him and not us, with gratitude of heart, and that we would especially remember those who labor for the Lord, sacrificing throughout the entire year, their all upon the altar of God. Also especially remembering the work of God in its various details, that the work of God and the fame of Jesus may go abroad among all people, that through these special gifts and offerings the world shall again see the Star of Bethlehem, and be led like the Wise men of the East, to find their way with the Shepherds of the night to the Cradle of Bethelem, where the Lamb of God may again be worshiped.

EVANSTON STUDENTS BEAT MAYOR, POLICE, SET FIRE TO HOUSE

Evanston, Ill., Nov. 24.

Eight students at Northwestern University are under arrest and more are to be rounded up today as a result of a riot last night in which 2,000 students battled more than 100 policemen, Evanston's Fire department and an organized crowd of World war veterans.

The riot, a protest against Michigan's claim to an undisputed football championship in the big ten" conference, reached its climax with the burning of an abandoned fraternity house and an attempt to burn the university's wooden football bleachers.

The rioting started about 10 o'clock and continued for three hours. When tear bombs and firearms used by the police failed to quell the students an appeal for help was sent to the Chicago police department and a detachment of 30 officers was sent from there.

Stripped of Badges

The students stripped Evanston policemen of their badges, clubs and revolvers. They forced some of the officers to head a snake dance.

According to the Mayor, property damage will run into thousands of dollars. Among victims were the mayor, who was slugged when he tried to quell disorder; Police Chief's automobile was overturned and badly damaged, one policeman thrown to ground when he attempted to draw a revolver, was removed to a hospital with two broken ribs. Another policeman was beaten, two citizens were trampled.

Eight Are Held

Four students arrested gave their names. They with the four arrested today are being held pending further investigation.

nausenm. Lately I have traced the development of Mesmerism into hypnotism and its later forms of Coueism and psycho-analysis and its further application in practical psychology.

All this has brought me face to face with the fact that Jesus taught on Galilee and demonstrated by his works, all and more than all these modern scientists have been grouping towards in their long years of study and investigations.

Then a camp meeting was advertised to begin here with Charles F. Parham as the principal evangelist. Brother Parham was with us a few days before his tent arrived and then he camped on the ground. Here we had a living example of Christs healing. Our neighbors around Cheney knew Brother Parham when the doctors gave him up to die. He was drawn nearly double with rheumatism, every joint ossifying and every organ of his body diseased. Yet when he called upon the Lord he was healed of all but the weak ankles and later, in the same manner, was healed of the weak ankles. There were about seventy five people here who had received the baptism of the Holy Ghost, two women who sang original hymns in tongues and then interpreted by singing over in English and several received the baptism here.

There was only one point that I could not accept and that was the immaculate conception. So accepting Jesus as the worlds greatest teacher I went to the altar for prayers, Sept. 17, 1925. That night about 4 a.m. I was waked up and impressed to get up and pray for guidance on that point. I did so and soon received a vision of the light of the spirit and in an instant, the following information: "Jesus is the child of love of Mary for the Holy Spirit and not the result of carnal gratification. The Holy Spirit abode with Mary and caused the development of one male cell in the rudimentary male organs, which are present in all females, and this cell passing from the male to the female organs became the progenitor of the child Jesus. He is therefore born of an immaculate conception, the child of the Holy Spirit and the third person in the Godhead."

Having received a Divine Revelation on the point that I could not get any other way, I returned to my bed and went to sleep. The next night I was awakened about the same time and given a vision of the light of the Spirit with the Saviors face plainly shown in the center of it. No message was given at that time.
