TOTAL HIGHSPEED LINNEA AND CRYSTAL BROOKE COVE STREET DAMAGE.

Jon Mullenburg, 1630 W. Hummingbird Lane, Nixa, MO contractor for Total Highspeed stated the damage to Linnea and Crystal Brooke Cove has already been addressed. Danderson stated a test strip was okayed to see if that would be enough to fix the issue. The street has continued to deteriorate. Mullenburg stated this is not their issue they did what they were supposed to do. Roger DeLong with Total Highspeed Internet was present to discuss street damage. Mayor sent bid for work needed to Roger DeLong. Roger acknowledges the street damage and stated it needs to be fixed. Roger stated if bid for repair was less than \$30,000 he could of just wrote a check but it is over (\$33,000). Roger needs to go back to Travis Allen for approval.

APPROVE AND OR DISCUSS CC LIFT STATION UPGRADE.

Roe reported two bids for CC Lift Station has been received and a third should be in at any time. Bert Bond with Clean Stream is present to discuss upgrade issue. The third bid should be in by tomorrow. Roe does not want to hold up progress for another two weeks.
