All-Electric Vehicles

If you are considering purchasing an electric-only car, please be aware that these vehicles **cannot** be charged in our parkade.

Charging an electric vehicle requires an outlet that can deliver at least 208 volts of power to charge the car in about 5 hours. This kind of power was not installed in our parkade, and the present electrical outlets in the parkade cannot be used to charge a vehicle.

If there is sufficient interest in electric vehicles, strata can look into the cost and feasibility of having a 208 volt, 3 phase panel installed in our building power vault that could support charging stations. It could be an expensive retrofit, however, and a majority of owners would have to approve of the cost.
