Class Descriptions and Important Information

Course Descriptions | Grades 2-6

Art: Explore art through the use of different mediums, such as drawing, painting and more! This class will foster a love of art and design. Artists will learn what it means to be creative, and how to use art as a form of expression.

Drama: The realm of drama will be explored through various avenues such as set design, painting, acting, directing, sound, costumes, lighting, makeup, designing a playbill and more! Families are invited for a finale performance on the last day of camp!

Lego Engineering: Power-up your engineering skills with over 100,000 pieces of Legos! Kids will apply real world concepts in physics, engineering, and architecture through projects designed by real engineers! Each day's projects are geared uniquely to challenge each student's abilities. We will explore motorized, mechanized, and architectural projects using Legos in a fun way!

Let's Get Cooking: Are you crazy for cooking and trying new foods? Students will be exposed to the Culinary Arts in a fun, nutritious, and edible way! Students will learn about safety, tools of the kitchen, and cultural origins of the foods prepared. Daily, students will make a healthy and appealing snack to enjoy. Students will plan appetizers, breakfast, lunch, dinner and dessert and will learn the necessary elements of dishwasher, prep cook, sous chef, and chef. No experience necessary! ***If your child has food allergies, it is advised that he/she take an alternate class for safety reasons.**

Wild Card: Calling all energetic students! Do you like athletics and adventure? Do you like surprises? Each day will be a new surprise with exciting activities! Be prepared to be active or learn a new sport. Activities may include futsal, basketball, hockey, obstacle courses, dodgeball, and more! Come join the fun in our Wildcard Class!

Super Science~ Black Holes, Supernovas, and Stars!: Join us for an investigation of how chemical elements are formed in the **stars**, the power of a **supernova** explosion, and the gravity of a **black hole**--let's eat one before it eats us! Participants are invited to a special sky viewing event on Monday night, June 26th at the VES lower ball field.

GoPro Fun: We'll help your child and your GoPro reach new heights of complexity and storytelling in this four-day training/recording adventure intended to improve video skills and imagination. Video camera required (GoPro or not). Each day of class will show inspiring video segments, assign and teach video tasks, record video on campus, and teach post production steps. A finished v-story or a collection of worthy segments will be completed by the end of the camp.

Session One: Fill your morning with exciting, interactive, enriching activities! Students will be in their own self-contained classroom with a certificated teacher and great volunteers for support!
