church.

## **OUR GUIDELINES:**

- We will support only those missionaries who have given a clear testimony to the fact of their eternal salvation through faith in the finished work of Christ; their baptism by immersion after salvation, and their current and continued membership in an independent, Bible-believing, Baptist church.
- We will support only full-time missionaries that have some local church ministry experience and have been ordained by the confirming call of their local church.
- We will support only those missionaries who are in agreement with our doctrines, policies, and purpose at Southland Baptist Church.
- We will support only those missionaries who are presently active in leading others to Christ and discipling converts.
- We will support only those missionaries whose purpose, plan, and call of God is to follow the Biblical Pattern of church planting, church building and soul-winning.
- We will support only those missionaries who have received proper Bible instruction and missionary training for the endeavor for which they pursue.
- We will support only those missionaries who are working with a mission board and/or sending and commissioning church of like faith and practice.
- We will support only those missionaries who have been carefully examined in regard to these statements.

## **RESPONSIBILITES ON THE FIELD:**

- To send a newsletter update at least once a quarter.
   To patify our paster immediately of any changes in ministry, location, or destring street
- To notify our pastor immediately of any changes in ministry, location, or doctrinal stand.
- To notify our church of any unusual hardships or pressing needs.
- To submit to reevaluation every four years or during a furlough visit.
