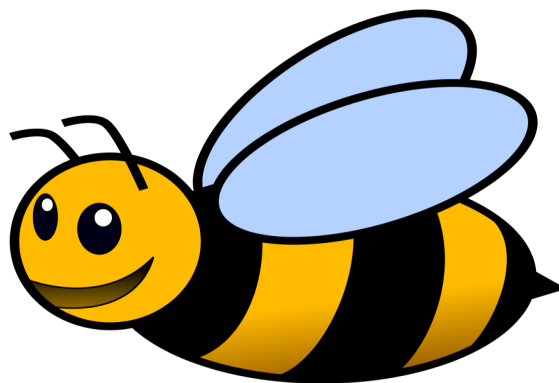

WHAT IS A RHYMING WORD?

A *rhyming word* is a word that has the same sound at the end. Only the beginning sounds of a pair of rhyming words are different.

Look at the following words and their **ending sounds**. Notice how the words **Man** and **Tan** both end with the sound "**an**". The word **Hat** ends in "**at**" so it does not rhyme with the other words.

Man	M <u>a n</u>	✓
Tan	T <u>a n</u>	✓
Hat	H a t
