First Lesson Genesis 1:24-28 [24](#) Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind"; and it was so. [25](#) And God made the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. [26](#) Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." [27](#) So God

created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. [28](#) Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Second Lesson Acts 2:14a, 22-36 [14](#) But Peter, standing up with the eleven, raised his voice and said to them, [22](#) "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know--[23](#) Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death;[24](#) whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it. [25](#) For David says concerning Him: 'I foresaw the Lord always before my face, For He is at my right hand, that I may not be shaken. [26](#) Therefore my heart rejoiced, and my tongue was glad; Moreover my flesh also will rest in hope. [27](#) For You will not leave my soul in Hades, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption. [28](#) You have made known to me the ways of life; You will make me full of joy in Your presence.' [29](#) "Men and brethren, let me speak freely to you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. [30](#) Therefore, being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, [31](#) he, foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that His soul was not left in Hades, nor did His flesh see corruption. [32](#) This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. [33](#) Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear. [34](#) For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, [35](#) Till I make Your enemies Your footstool." [36](#) "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."
