Chet, age 91, passed away April 26, 2013. Chet, known to us as WA6PAC, was 4 C's life member since 1994. Chet had a rich full life in which ham radio had a major part. Chet was sometimes heard on the repeater as one of our net controllers. Chet was born in Schenectady, NY and earned an electrical engineering degree from Princeton. He served in the US Navy during World War II as lieutenant. Chet worked for General Electric. He moved to Kentfield in 1963. He owned The Smile Company camping and sporting goods store in San Francisco. He will be missed by many.



"Red" Layton Bryant, N6UMG

Red, age 78, passed away April 9, 2013. Red and Jan (N6UYE) have been 4 C'S club members since 1988. Red was a long time Repeater controller for the club. Red was a former Reserve Officer with the San Pablo Police Department while working for American Standard in Richmond. Before retiring in 1991, Layton was a Teamster driving for Loomis Armored Car Service. Red was known worldwide as the host of the ham operators' "Uncle Herb's Do Drop Inn" on CO100. N6UMG's wit and humor will be missed on several continents. Red was also a contributor to the Find A Grave project. "Find A Grave is a free resource for finding the final resting places of famous folks, friends and family members. Contributors provide valuable help to genealogy researchers.
