RESOLUTION ENACTING NINETY (90) DAY BUILDING MORATORIUM ON ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR GROUND MOUNTED SOLAR INSTALLATIONS

WHEREAS, as the residents of the Town of Union Vale convert from traditional methods of power generation to the use of solar, the Town Board deems it necessary to examine the provisions of its Zoning Code to determine whether it contains adequate protections from physical, environmental and visual impacts from ground mounted installations and, to the extent necessary, make revisions to the Zoning Code to ensure adequate protections are put in place.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board has reviewed the Short Form Environmental Assessment Form as it relates to the adoption of the moratorium and hereby adopts a Negative Declaration under SEQRA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Union Vale hereby adopts a ninety (90) day moratorium on the issuance of building permits for ground mounted solar installations.
