A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Sahrle to exit executive session and to enter into regular session at 8:05 pm, with the following action taken: To hold a special meeting on June 23, 2016 at 5:30 pm at the Village Office and for the Village Clerk to send Chris Martz a certified letter regarding the special meeting. The motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Cox had concerns regarding the speed limits on North Dansville and South Main Street. He was approached by concerned residents that live on both streets and feels that the speed limits should be lowered at the Village line. A letter will be sent to the NYS DOT regarding the issue.

A motion was made by Mayor Cox, seconded by Trustee Azzi to set the speed limit on North Dansville Street and South Main Street to 30 MPH at the Village lines. The motion carried 5-0.
