Rules

First Friday Scavenger Hunt

Friday, February 3, 2017

Registration & Check-In:

- Teams can have up to four members.
- Check-in will take place at the Dragonfly Cafe located at 9 E. Broad St. beginning at 5:00 PM. ***Clues will not be distributed before check-in.
- Team members must stay together during the hunt.

Must Haves:

- For each clue, the team will be required to figure out both the location and an object (artwork, sign, etc.) at that location. For example, a clue may direct teams to a particular restaurant. Once there, another aspect of the clue will drive teams to find a particular object in that location.
- At some locations teams will be required to take a photo of the object described by the clue
 using a Polaroid, digital, or phone camera. Teams must supply their own camera and
 cameras must have room to store up to 10 pictures. All photos for each team must be
 taken on the same camera.

Recording and Photographing Answers:

- The team sheet will provide clues and space for teams to record their answers. Each clue leads to a location and an object at the location. As previously stated, teams must also take a picture of the object they find at some locations (per the instructions). These photos will need to be shown to the judges when the answer sheet is turned in.
- Teams must also record the name of the location/venue on their team sheet.

Point Values:

As previously mentioned, each clue leads to a location and an object at the location. All
objects answered correctly are worth one point. All locations are worth varied points based on
the distance from the check-in location.

Disqualification:

Any team that submits their answer sheet after 8 PM will not be eligible for prizes.

Submitting Clue Sheets

- There will be a table with judges set up inside the Sage Exchange (11 E. Broad St.). Teams
 must submit their answer sheets to the judges by 8 PM, or earlier, to qualify for prizes.
 Teams must also show photos of objects that were required to be taken.
- Once an answer sheet is submitted, the team cannot add or change answers.
- After the teams have submitted their answer sheets, participants are invited to enjoy the after-party.
- The judges will calculate points based on the point value for locations and answers provided.
- The team with the most points is allowed to have the first choice among the prizes. The team with the second highest number of points will be allowed to choose from the remaining two prizes. The third place team will win the third prize. If teams tie for points then prizes will be based upon a drawing.
