General Show Info

Entries: Entries will be accepted for sixty-five riders. Others will be waitlisted. Secretary will notify you once your entry has been accepted.

Schooling Day: October 1st: Schooling is available at \$25.00 per horse and open from 3-6pm.

Oct 2nd-Show Day: Schooling rings open at 7:00am. No riding in the show rings before show starts but hand walking is allowed until 30 min prior to start of show. Horses must enter a minimum of 2 classes or be charged non-showing fee of \$50.00. No classes can be added the day of the show.

RPHSA Membership: An \$8.00 RPHSA Non-Member Fee will apply to non-member riders.

Stabling Options (minimum 1 bag shavings required \$9/bag):

- Stabling stall for Saturday schooling, overnight and Sunday stall- total \$100
- Stabling Saturday overnight (arrive at 6pm or later----no schooling) and Sunday stall \$70
- Stabling Sunday ONLY stall \$50

Horses can arrive October 1st (Saturday) after 2:00pm and no later than 7pm.

Awards: Show themed ribbons first through sixth place.

Six high percentage awards: Intro Jr & Adult, Training Jr & Adult, Upper level Jr & Adult.

Times: Ride times will be posted at www.rphsa.com on or after Sept 28th

One form per rider and horse combination. Riders can enter a max of three riding tests.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT:

This Agreement, between Carriage House, Ann Bower, and all trainers, teachers, employees, managers and members (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Carriage House") and the person(s) executing this document (hereinafter referred to as "Client"). In consideration for, Client voluntarily agrees to the terms of this RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT and hereby agrees to personally assume the risks associated with horse riding, training, teaching and boarding services as set forth below. Client hereby releases, waives, and forever discharges Carriage House of all actions of whatever kind or nature either in law or in equity arising from or by reason of any bodily injury or personal injuries known or unknown, death, or property damage - including damage to Client's horse and other personal property – resulting during Client's presence on Carriage House's premises and any activity involving Carriage House's services so long as such injury, property damage, or death is not caused by an intentional, willful, or wanton act or omission of Carriage House (i.e. Client releases Carriage House from liability for damages caused by Carriage House's negligence only). Client assumes full responsibility for the risk of bodily injury, death, or property damage from such activities, and shall hold Carriage House harmless for any liability thereof as set forth herein. Client further agrees that if a claim or lawsuit is made against Carriage House or its owners, members, agents, and/or employees for any injury or damage brought by, or allegedly attributable to, Client arising from Client's presence on Carriage House's premises or any activity involving Carriage House's services, Client will pay all attorney's fees and costs reasonably incurred by Carriage House to defend that claim or lawsuit and will reimburse Carriage House for any judgment, expense, or other damage incurred. This release is given on behalf of Client, Client's spouse, and Client's legal representatives, administrators, executors, heirs, and assigns, and in the case of any child or children of Client's, on behalf of them and their legal representatives, administrators, executors,
